- 2 BYRNE OF NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS OUTSTANDING ATHLETIC
- 3 RECOGNITION IN BEING VOTED MISS-LOU ATHLETE OF THE CENTURY.
- 4 WHEREAS, Tony Byrne, who was elected Mayor of Natchez,
- 5 Mississippi, in 1968 and held that office until 1988, made
- 6 football fields, basketball courts and football fields around
- 7 Mississippi his own playground, setting state records in baseball
- 8 and basketball at Natchez High School; and
- 9 WHEREAS, because of his accomplishments in the 1950's, Mayor
- 10 Byrne was voted Miss-Lou Athlete of the Century by popular vote of
- 11 the readers of the <u>Natchez Democrat</u>; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Tony Byrne was grace personified on the hardwood, as
- 13 well as the gridiron, which is why he was All Big Eight in both
- 14 sports while royally entertaining crowds playing both sports at
- 15 Natchez High School; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Byrne is the only person to win a scoring title in
- 17 football and basketball in the former Big Eight Conference, which
- 18 was comprised of all of the big schools in Mississippi: in 1953,
- 19 Byrne tallied 192 points in football, scoring a record 32
- 20 touchdowns as a senior, and in 1954, as a basketball senior he led
- 21 Natchez to its second straight league championship, scoring a
- 22 record 716 points; and
- 23 WHEREAS, when Tony set the new Big Eight Conference standard
- 24 for single-season touchdowns in 1953, he rushed for 781 yards on
- 25 touchdown runs alone (that's 24.4 yards per touchdown); he scored
- 26 4 touchdowns in 6 different games; he had 16 scoring runs of 20

- 27 yards or more; he had 11 scoring runs of 30 yards or more; he
- 28 averaged 180 yards per game; on the season he had 1802 yards in 10
- 29 games (that was 1170 yards rushing on 130 runs for a 9-yard
- 30 average); obviously the 1953 football season was very special and
- 31 exciting for Natchez High School fans; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Tony Byrne's basketball exploits are also legendary;
- 33 he set a new Big Eight Conference single-game scoring standard of
- 34 42 points and set a season scoring record of 716 points in a
- 35 championship basketball season; and
- 36 WHEREAS, Tony plays excellent tennis in his retirement years,
- 37 and says he appreciates more now the accomplishments he and his
- 38 teammates achieved; and
- 39 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 40 individual, whose intense athleticism and civic pride brought
- 41 honor to his school, his community and to the State of
- 42 Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 44 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 45 we do hereby commend and congratulate Tony Byrne of Natchez,
- 46 Mississippi, for his outstanding athletic recognition in being
- 47 voted Miss-Lou Athlete of the Century, and wish him success in all
- 48 his future endeavors.
