- 18 valor of the Americans who sacrificed their lives for the
- 19 liberation of their country, solidify the bonds of friendship that
- 20 exist between the United States and Luxembourg, and join together
- 21 with young Americans in the promotion of peace expressed through
- 22 the universal language of music; and
- WHEREAS, Mississippi has been honored by having the Oak Grove
- 24 High School Band from Lamar County invited to participate in a
- 25 festival of friendship, commemoration and music in Luxembourg at
- 26 the Luxembourg-American Cemetery; and
- 27 WHEREAS, the Oak Grove High School Band is one of only eleven
- 28 high school bands in the United States that have been invited to
