SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 591 (As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING PATRICK 2 COX, JR., OF PEARL, MISSISSIPPI, FOR EARNING THE "YES I CAN!" INTERNATIONAL HONOR RECOGNIZING OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS OF 3 CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH DISABILITIES. 4 5 WHEREAS, Patrick Cox, Jr., of Pearl, a champion cutting-horse rider, has been named a recipient of the "Yes I Can!" award, an 6 7 international honor recognizing outstanding achievements of children and youth with disabilities; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Patrick, 19, who is legally blind and wears a 10 hearing aid to compensate for a severe to profound hearing loss, out of thousands of nominees from the United States, Canada and 11 Russia, is one of only 35 selected for the tribute this year by 12 the Foundation for Exceptional Children; and 13 WHEREAS, he will receive the award in an April 7 ceremony in 14 Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, from "Yes I Can!" spokesman 15 Neil Smith, an all-pro defensive end for the NFL's Denver Broncos; 16 17 and WHEREAS, Cox was nominated by Mississippi Lieutenant Governor 18 19 Amy Tuck, a friend of the Cox family, and Brenda Wagner, special 20 education director for Pearl public schools; and WHEREAS, he entered formal competition for the first time 21 22 less than two years ago, and has since won several awards in the 23 exacting cutting-horse competition, including Dixie National 24 events in Jackson; and 25 WHEREAS, Patrick saddles up with a Velcro seatbelt and wears 26 a cowboy hat pulled over a batting helmet to protect his head; the

27 helmet is wired with voice-activated communicators, enabling his

30 WHEREAS, Patrick's next competition will be March 18, during 31 the National Cutting Horse Association's Chevy Trucks Eastern 32 National Championships in Jackson; it will be his last appearance 33 in youth competition, his father said; thereafter he will compete 34 as an adult; and

35 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the 36 achievements of this remarkable young man who has brought honor to 37 his community, his fellow disabled youth and to the State of 38 Mississippi:

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 40 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That 41 we do hereby commend and congratulate Patrick Cox, Jr., of Pearl, 42 Mississippi, for earning the "Yes I Can!" International Honor 43 recognizing outstanding achievements of children and youth with 44 disabilities, and wish him continued success in future 45 competitions and in all of his future endeavors.
