- Architect/Assistant Director of the Bureau of Building, Grounds 17
- and Real Property Management, and in 1992, he was promoted to 18
- Director of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 19

- WHEREAS, throughout his tenure as director, Jerry Oakes has 2.1

- 23 buildings and the renovation of many others; and
- WHEREAS, Jerry A. Oakes holds a Bachelor of Architecture from 24

- 36 WHEREAS, Jerry Oakes and his wife, Jane, have three children
- 37 and two grandchildren; and

- 39 special tribute to such an outstanding citizen as Jerry Oakes,
