- 9 for Biggs, Weir and Chandler, Architects & Engineers, in Jackson,

- 11 WHEREAS, Jerry Oakes continued his work in the private sector
- 12 by working for William R. Henry, Jr., Architect,
- 13 (Architect/Draftsman, 1960-1966); Charles G. Mitchell, Architect,
- 14 (Architect, 1966-1969); and Mitchell & Oakes Architects (Partner,
- 15 1970-1977); and
- 16 WHEREAS, in 1978, Jerry Oakes accepted the position of Chief
- 17 Architect/Assistant Director of the Bureau of Building, Grounds
- 18 and Real Property Management, and in 1992, he was promoted to
- 19 Director of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property
- 20 Management; and
- 21 WHEREAS, throughout his tenure as director, Jerry Oakes has
- 22 been responsible for the construction of numerous state government
- 23 buildings and the renovation of many others; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Jerry A. Oakes holds a Bachelor of Architecture from
- 25 Auburn University in Auburn, Alabama, and maintains several
- 26 professional certifications, such as Registered Architect, State

- 27 of Mississippi (1964-present); Member of American Institute of
- 28 Architects (1959-present); Member of Construction Specification
- 29 Institute (1967-present); and Southeastern States Conference on
- 30 Capital Outlay & Construction Administrators (1979-present); and
- 31 WHEREAS, Jerry Oakes is a retired Captain in the United
- 32 States Army Corps of Engineers (1965); served in the 926th
- 33 Engineer Construction Battalion, Berlin Crisis (1961-1962); served
- 34 in the 17th Engineering Battalion, Second Armored Division
- 35 (1957-1959); and was a Commissioned Second Lieutenant (1957); and
- 36 WHEREAS, Jerry Oakes and his wife, Jane, have three children
- 37 and two grandchildren; and
- 38 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds it most appropriate to pay
- 39 special tribute to such an outstanding citizen as Jerry Oakes,
- 40 whose dedication and loyalty to state government has brought many
- 41 contributions to this state:
