SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 600  
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MASTER  
2 SERGEANT ANTHONY AALBERTSBERG UPON HIS RETIREMENT AFTER 20 YEARS  
3 OF SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE AND TO HIS COUNTRY.

4 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Anthony J. Aalbertsberg is retiring  
5 after 20 years of decorated service to the United States Air Force  
6 and to his country; and

7 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Anthony J. Aalbertsberg is  
8 Instructor Supervisor, 366TRS Det6, Gulfport Naval Construction  
9 Battalion Center, Mississippi, is senior training instructor  
10 responsible for operations for Civil Engineer Structural  
11 Technician School, and manages the Air Force instructors in both  
12 the combined and unique tracks, as well as the supplemental  
13 courses; and

14 WHEREAS, he is a subject matter expert coordinating with the  
15 Navy host on inter-service technical training issues; and

16 WHEREAS, Sergeant Aalbertsberg enlisted at the Air Force  
17 Basic Training Station at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, in  
18 November 1979, and for the majority of his career, he has served  
19 in the Structural Career Field; he started out as a Masonry  
20 Specialist assigned to 2853 Civil Engineering Squadron; key jobs  
21 include tours as Prime BEEF Logistics NCO, Facility Maintenance  
22 Team leader, Instructor and First Sergeant; and

23 WHEREAS, his major awards and decorations include the Air  
24 Force Commendation Medal and the Air Force Achievement Medal; and

25 WHEREAS, Sergeant Aalbertsberg was born in Utercht, Holland,  
26 and raised in Detroit, Michigan, is married to the former Rita G.

27 Hammonds and they have two children, Andrew (Andy) and Amelia  
28 (Amie); and

29 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the long  
30 and dedicated service of this man who has served his country and  
31 through his civic and professional activities through the Gulfport  
32 Naval Construction Battalion Center has contributed much to the  
33 State of Mississippi:
