21 WHEREAS, Gerald McRaney has starred in various CBS Television 22 Network series, including eight years as private investigator Rick 23 Simon in "Simon & Simon," four years as "Major Dad" and one year 24 in "Central Park West," and his television credits also include a 25 long string of highly rated films, including "1,000 Men and a 26 Baby," "Someone She Knows," "A Stranger Beside Me" and "The People
