1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO SUSPEND JOINT RULE 40 FOR THE
2 DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF A BILL
3 ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
4 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS TO THE
5 SOUTHEASTERN STATES' ESTIMATED AVERAGE OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD, BY
6 EARMARKING DISCRETIONARY FUNDS IN THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE'S
7 OUT-YEAR BUDGET PLAN; TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE
8 OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM PROGRAM ALLOTMENT FOR SUPPORTIVE
9 SERVICES IN CONFORMITY THERETO; TO AMEND SECTION 37-21-7,
10 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF ASSISTANT

15 OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD, BY EARMARKING DISCRETIONARY FUNDS IN THE
16 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE'S OUT-YEAR BUDGET PLAN; AND FOR RELATED
17 PURPOSES.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
19 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That Joint Rule 40 of
20 the Senate and the House is hereby suspended for the purpose of
21 requesting the drafting, introduction, consideration and passage,
22 regardless of any deadlines imposed by said rule, of a bill
23 entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
24 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS TO THE
25 SOUTHEASTERN STATES' ESTIMATED AVERAGE OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD, BY
26 EARMARKING DISCRETIONARY FUNDS IN THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE'S
27 OUT-YEAR BUDGET PLAN; TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE
28 OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM PROGRAM ALLOTMENT FOR SUPPORTIVE
29 SERVICES IN CONFORMITY THERETO; TO AMEND SECTION 37-21-7,
