SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 621
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE WEST LAUDERDALE HIGH
2 SCHOOL SOCCER TEAM FOR ITS OUTSTANDING 2000 SEASON.

4 the 2000 season by winning the Class 1, 2 and 3A State
5 Championship; and
