REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2158: Property assessment; assess owners of certain land who sell reforestation easements in South Delta Pump project area.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

13 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section:

14 (a) "Project" means the Yazoo Basin, Yazoo Backwater,
15 Mississippi, Project authorized by the Flood Control Act of 18
16 August 1941 and the Water Resources Development Act of 1986.

(b) "Project area" means land in Humphreys, Issaquena,
Sharkey, Warren, Washington and Yazoo Counties located at or below
the one hundred-year frequency flood elevation.

(c) "Reforestation easement" means an easement on open agricultural land located in the project area that restricts the future use of the property to woodlands that is purchased from a landowner by the Corps of Engineers or other governmental entity for purposes specifically related to the project.

The board of supervisors of any county in the project 25 (2) 26 area may, in its discretion, require all landowners in the county 27 who sell reforestation easements in the project area for purposes specifically related to the project to annually pay a fee in an 28 29 amount not to exceed Four Dollars (\$4.00) per acre, on each acre of property for which a landowner sold such an easement. 30 The 31 proceeds of the fee shall be used by the board of supervisors to provide services such as road maintenance, fire protection and 32 33 police protection, and other services necessary for the 34 maintenance and protection of reforestation easements in the 35 project area. If the federal government provides funds to

36 counties in the project area which may be used by the counties to provide such services necessary for the maintenance and protection 37 38 of reforestation easements in the project area, the board of supervisors of a county receiving such federal funds shall reduce 39 40 any fee imposed under this section by a proportionate amount based on the ratio that the amount of federal funds received by the 41 42 county bears to the cost of providing such services. 43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

44 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY IN 2THE YAZOO BASIN, YAZOO BACKWATER, MISSISSIPPI, PROJECT AREA, TO 3REQUIRE LANDOWNERS WHO SELL REFORESTATION EASEMENTS IN SUCH 4PROJECT AREA TO ANNUALLY PAY A FEE ON EACH ACRE OF PROPERTY FOR 5WHICH A LANDOWNER SOLD SUCH AN EASEMENT FOR PURPOSES SPECIFICALLY 6RELATED TO THE PROJECT; TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF SUCH FEE; TO 7PROVIDE THAT THE PROCEEDS OF THE FEE SHALL BE USED BY THE BOARD OF 8SUPERVISORS TO PROVIDE SERVICES SUCH AS ROAD MAINTENANCE, FIRE 9PROTECTION AND POLICE PROTECTION AND OTHER SERVICES NECESSARY FOR 10 THE MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF REFORESTATION EASEMENTS IN THE 11PROJECT AREA; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
