1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend as follows:

Line 9: Delete \$99,572,641.00; insert \$100,375,171.00

Line 15: Delete \$28,329,648.00; insert \$27,527,120.00

Line 74: Delete \$2,846,003.00; insert \$2,870,408.00

Line 82: Delete \$796,694.00; insert \$772,288.00

Line 104: Delete \$14,391,612.00; insert \$14,515,025.00

Line 110: Delete \$4,028,705.00; insert \$3,905,292.00

Line 123: Delete \$790,098.00; insert \$5,839,750.00

Line 131: Delete \$620,847.00; insert \$1,571,194.00

Delete lines 132 through 139 in their entirety

Lines 158 and 159 by deleting the words "Health Care Expendable"

before the word "Fund" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "State General"

Line 187: Delete \$10,053,490.00; insert \$11,510,674.00

Further amend by inserting a new Section 17 and renumbering subsequent sections, said new section to read as follows:

SECTION 17. It is the intent of the Legislature that no faculty salaries be reduced.
