18	Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
19	in lieu thereof the following:

21	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
22	(a) "Project" means the Yazoo Basin, Yazoo Backwater,
23	Mississippi, Project authorized by the Flood Control Act of 18
24	August 1941 and the Water Resources Development Act of 1986.
25	(b) "Project area" means land in Humphreys, Issaquena,
26	Sharkey, Warren, Washington and Yazoo Counties located at or below
27	the one hundred-year frequency flood elevation.
28	(c) "Reforestation easement" means an easement on open
29	agricultural land located in the project area purchased by the
30	Corps of Engineers or other entity, as a result of the project,
31	from a landowner that restricts the future use of the property to
32	woodlands.
33	(d) "Local taxing district" means any county,
34	municipality, school district or other local entity that levies an
35	ad valorem tax or for which an ad valorem tax is levied, to fund
36	all or a portion of its budget.
37	(2) The board of supervisors of any county in the project
38	area may, in its discretion, require all landowners in the county
39	who sell reforestation easements in the project area to annually

40 pay to the county tax collector an assessment equal to any

- 41 decrease in the amount of ad valorem taxes that would have been
- 42 paid by the landowner on such property if the property had the
- 43 same use that it had prior to the sale of such easement.
- 44 (3) Assessments shall be paid to the county in the same
- 45 manner as ad valorem tax payments are made.
- 46 (4) Assessments received by county tax collectors shall be
- 47 distributed to local taxing districts as reimbursement for ad
- 48 valorem taxes that are lost as a result of the sale of
- 49 reforestation easements. Payments received by a local taxing
- 50 district pursuant to this section shall be utilized in the same
- 51 manner as ad valorem tax receipts.
- 52 SECTION 2. This act shall be repealed one (1) day after its
- 53 passage.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 55 and after its passage.
