5 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 6 in lieu thereof the following:

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- 8 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Beginning with the 2000-2001 school year,
  9the assignment of K-12 school guidance counselors to the
  10particular schools within the district shall be at the discretion
  11of the local school board with the following restriction: No
  12individual shall be employed as a school guidance counselor
  13without appropriate training and certification as determined by
  14the State Department of Education.
- 15 (2) School guidance counselors shall provide the following 16 comprehensive counseling services:
- 17 (a) Academic and personal/social counseling;
- 18 (b) Student assessment and assessment counseling;
- 19 (c) Career and educational counseling;
- 20 (d) Individual and group counseling (large/small);
- 21 (e) Crisis intervention and preventive counseling;
- 22 (f) Referrals to community agencies;
- 23 (g) Educational consultations and collaboration with
- 24 teachers, administrators, parents, and community leaders;
- 25 (h) Educational and career placement services;
- 26 (i) Follow-up counseling services.
- 27 (3) The State Department of Education may adopt regulations

28regarding the activities of the school guidance counselor as are 29not inconsistent with this section.

30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31and after July 1, 2000.
