## \*\*\*Adopted\*\*\* AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

## Senate Bill NO. 3178

## By Representative(s) Committee

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 7 in lieu thereof the following:

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SECTION 1. (1) The State Board for Community and Junior 10 Colleges is authorized and empowered to establish an Equipment 11Leasing and Purchase Program for the use of the colleges; to adopt 12 policies and procedures to implement such program; to establish 13 such offices or subordinate units as may be necessary for the 14administration of such program; to adopt rules and regulations 15 pertaining to such program; to acquire by purchase, lease or 16 lease/purchase contract and retain or transfer ownership or 17possession of instructional and other equipment; to contract for 18the leasing of such properties and for the financing of leases and 19 purchases; to make such purchases and enter into such leases 20 according to the requirements of the state master lease-purchase 21 laws (as provided under Section 31-7-10) and the requirements of 22the laws establishing the Mississippi Department of Information 23Technology Services for the state; to enter in lease financing 24 agreements in connection therewith; and to require the transfer of 25appropriations for general funds or self-generated funds from the 26 community and junior colleges to the Community and Junior Colleges 27 Equipment Leasing and Purchase Program Repayment Fund, which is 28 established as a separate fund in the State Treasury, or such

29 other funds as the board may determine appropriate or useful or as 30 may be required in connection with any lease financing agreements.

31 Interest earned on any funds held in the fund on behalf of the 32 separate colleges shall be credited to the colleges on a pro rata

33basis based upon purchases through the fund.

- 34 (2) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to 35be known as the "Community and Junior Colleges Equipment Leasing 36 and Purchase Program Proceeds Fund," into which shall be deposited 37 all funds used to implement the Equipment Leasing and Purchase 38 Program created under subsection (1) of this section. Any 39 unexpended balance in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall 40 carry over into the subsequent fiscal year and shall not lapse 41 into the State General Fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be 42 made upon requisition of the Executive Director of the State Board 43 for Community and Junior Colleges.
- 44 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 45 and after July 1, 2000.
