AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

5 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
6 in lieu thereof the following:

8 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
10 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
11 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
12 Department of Information Technology Services, for the fiscal year
13 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

15 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
16 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

22 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
23 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
24 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
25 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
26 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
27 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the

28Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
29Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
30determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
31appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
32act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
33that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
34cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
35Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
36the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
37action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
38annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
39appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
40reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
41requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
42such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

43 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
44the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

45 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
46used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
47being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
48act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

49 SECTION 3. In order to offset the cost of publishing the
50annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi
51Department of Information Technology Services is hereby
52authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer
53for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory,
54to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The
55contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite
56periods not to exceed two (2) years.

57 It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of
58Information Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising
59shall be used, to approve all proposed advertising submitted for
60use within such annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory.
61The department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in
62its discretion, to reject any and all bids submitted, and if all

63 bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a contract within
64 the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of any
65 such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the
66 comparable terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. No
67 sectarian, un-American, political, partisan or immoral
68 advertisement, as determined solely by the authority or its
69 successor, shall be accepted.

70 All moneys derived from sale of such advertising shall be
71 deposited in the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to
72 the credit of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology
73 Services.

74 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Information
75 Technology Services is hereby authorized to receive additional
76 funds from any state agency or other source, including one hundred
77 percent (100%) general-fund agencies, for the purpose of providing
78 data processing or telecommunications services to any governmental
79 organization contracting with the Mississippi Department of
80 Information Technology Services for such services. The
81 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is
82 further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One Million
83 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty
84 (20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions
85 listed in this act in order to provide the required data
86 processing or telecommunications services for such governmental
87 organizations, under the rules and regulations of the Department
88 of Finance and Administration.

89 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
90 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
91 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
92 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
93 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
94 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

95 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
96 and after July 1, 2000.
