AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill NO. 3258

5 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
6 in lieu thereof the following:

8 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
10 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
11 defraying the expenses of The University of Mississippi Medical
12 Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
13 June 30, 2001.....\$ 156,928,735.00.

14 SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for
16 expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student
17 fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or
18 otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of The
19 University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year
20 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
21\$ 378,154,099.00.

22 SECTION 3. Any escalations shall be made in accordance with
23 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

24 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
25 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
26 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
27 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

28 SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated and authorized for
29 expenditure under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the
30 University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the School
31 of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of Nursing, the
32 School of Health Related Professions, the Teaching Hospital and
33 the Medical Center Service Area. The University of Mississippi
34 Medical Center shall prepare and make available to the Legislature
35 an accounting of expenditures for each of the divisions listed in
36 this section at the beginning of the legislative session.

37 SECTION 5. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it
38 is the intent of the Legislature to enhance recognition of
39 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting
40 qualified registered nurses.

41 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, and the
42 funds authorized to be expended in Section 2, none may be used to
43 provide medical services on behalf of any state agency,
44 institution or political subdivision, except to the extent that
45 such agency, institution or political subdivision reimburses the
46 hospital for the cost of the services provided. Upon the
47 rendering of medical services to any such agency, institution or
48 political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an invoice for the
49 charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) days. In the event
50 that payment is not made within ninety (90) days, the hospital
51 shall discontinue providing services to that agency, institution,
52 or political subdivision until all outstanding charges have been
53 paid.

54 SECTION 7. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
55 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
56 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
57 Mississippi and Section 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

58 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
59 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for
60 Fiscal Year 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
61 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
62 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2001

63budget request process.

64 SECTION 9. Of the funds authorized for expenditure in
65Section 2, the following amounts shall be derived from the
66Education Enhancement Fund as follows:

67 (a) Five Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Two
68Hundred Thirty-three Dollars

69(\$5,644,233.00) shall be derived from funds deposited pursuant to
70Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

71 (b) Two Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-
72eight Dollars (\$261,668.00)shall be derived from funds deposited
73pursuant to Section 27-103-203 (1), Mississippi Code of 1972.

74 SECTION 10. Should revenues generated and deposited to the
75Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
76Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein
77from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
78Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and
79Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure
80that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

81 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
82the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
83credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
84warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
85Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
86proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

87 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
88and after July 1, 2000.
