The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 10 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the 11 expenses of the Department of Economic and Community Development 12for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 13June 30, 2001.....\$ 28,947,168.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 15 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 16Treasury to the credit of the Department of Economic and Community 17Development or the appropriate special fund for the purpose of 18defraying the expenses incurred in the operation of the various 19 divisions of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 202000 and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 122,207,454.00. SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 22 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 23 Full Time..... 2.4 Permanent: 310

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 28 29the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 30 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 31Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 32 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 33are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 34Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 35Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 36determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 37appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 38act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 39that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 40 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 41Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 42the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 43action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 44annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 45appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 46 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 47requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be solved to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are slbeing used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this seat and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 54amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 55be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 56the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community 57Development in operating the state welcome centers.
- SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and 59 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 60 other orders of or agreements involving any agency, 61 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United 62 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may

63become available during the fiscal year for the support of the
64Department of Economic and Community Development or any programs
65sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby
66authorized not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and

75Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of

78 Department of Economic and Community Development shall maintain 79 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 80 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 81 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 82 maintained for Fiscal Year 2000. It is further the intention of 83 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 84 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 85 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 86 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2001 budget request 87 process.

88 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the 89 amount of Eight Million Nine Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Dollars 90(\$8,924,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 91 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism 92 Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2001. The expenditure 93 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 9425-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

95 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the 96 amount of Two Million One Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Dollars 97(\$2,134,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is

The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 169 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for 170 support of Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, to strengthen the 171 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and 172 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 173 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi 174 economy.
