With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 35 36the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 41Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 48 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 49the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 50action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 51annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 52appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 53reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 54requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be for special funds and/or other special funds which are dobeing used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this flact and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- Provided, however, that all funds received from any and all

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63 sources shall be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury 64 to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market.

SECTION 3. The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable 66 rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate 67 and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce 68 marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for 69 regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said 70 facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable 71 charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the 72 area contiguous to the stadium. The net proceeds from such 73 parking shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of 74 the Mississippi Farmers Central Market and shall be used solely 75 for general maintenance and repair of the Central Market 76 facilities.

77 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
82 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
83 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
84 and after July 1, 2000.
