AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill NO. 3266**

4        **Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting**  
5 **in lieu thereof the following:**

7        SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of  
10 defraying the expenses of the Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory  
11 Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending  
12 June 30, 2001.....\$            1,027,727.00.

13        SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
14 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special  
15 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available  
16 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Veterinary  
17 Diagnostic Laboratory Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
18 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$            350,059.00.

19        SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions  
20 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

26        With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of

27the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to  
28make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal  
29Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001  
30funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions  
31are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the  
32Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the  
33Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall  
34determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all  
35appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this  
36act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure  
37that no single personnel action increases this projected annual  
38cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal  
39Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,  
40the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken  
41action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected  
42annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"  
43appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which  
44reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation  
45requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until  
46such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

47 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with  
48the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

49 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
50used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
51being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
52act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

53 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
54the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
55credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
56warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
57Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
58proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

59 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
60and after July 1, 2000.
