The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 9necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 10 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 11 maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Programs 12 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 13June 30, 2001.....\$ 5,301,229.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 15 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 16 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available, 17 for the support and maintenance of the Alcorn State University 18 Agricultural Programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, 19 and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,073,755.00. 20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 21following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 22Fund as follows:

- 31 SECTION 4. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 32 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 33 which are being used for salaries which are withdrawn and no 34 longer available.
- 35 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 36 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2002 shall be submitted to 37 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 38 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 39 during the Fiscal Year 2001 budget request process.
- SECTION 6. Should revenues generated and deposited to the 41Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), 42Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein 43from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 44Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and 45Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure 46that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.
- 47 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 48the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the 49amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be 50allocated to defray the cost of a Sweet Potato program in Bolivar 51County.
- SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 53the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 54credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 55warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 56Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 57proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
