It is the intention of the Legislature that if 26 the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly 27 or indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants,

Further, it is the 31 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special 32 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2001 33 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.

34 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 35agency's budget request for fiscal year 2002 shall be submitted to 36the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 37detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 38during the fiscal year 2001 budget request process.

39 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 40following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 41Fund as follows:

Should revenues generated and deposited to the 88Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), 89Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein 90from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 91Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and 92Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure 93that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

94 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that all 95proceeds from the sale of timber at the Delta Experimental Forest 96- Stoneville shall be used in the construction of a multi-purpose 97facility or other capital improvements as needed, at the

99 SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 100the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 101credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 102warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 103Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 104proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 105 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 106 and after July 1, 2000.
