7 **Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting**
8 **in lieu thereof the following:**

10 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State
12 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
13 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management
14 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et
15 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning
16 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 864,489.00.

17 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
19 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
20 Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source
21 funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the
22 support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year
23 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

25 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
26 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
27 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
28 expenditure:

49 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
50 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
51 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
52 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
53 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
54 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
55 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
56 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
57 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
58 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
59 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
60 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
61 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
62 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
63 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
64 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

65annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
66appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
67reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
68requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
69such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
71the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
73used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
74being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
75act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

76 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
77Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon
78the request of a local public emergency management organization in
79an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to
80rural water associations to enable their continued operation when
81the local emergency management organization determines that such
82private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the
83community.

84 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
85Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall
86provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors,
87mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in
88disaster management.

89 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
90necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
91General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency
92Management Agency to be used to establish a special reserve fund
93in the State Treasury for Disaster Relief, for the fiscal year
94beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
95.....\$ 99,750.00.

96 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
97necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
98Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund
99Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain

100 administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the
101 Disaster Relief Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
102 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 5,856,000.00.

103 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
104 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
105 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No.
106 372U for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses
107 and the federal share of the cost of the Hazard Mitigation
108 Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
109 June 30, 2001.....\$ 28,400,000.00.

110 SECTION 9. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
111 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
112 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No.
113 372T for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses
114 and the federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program
115 resulting from the April/May 1991 Flood, for the fiscal year
116 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
117\$ 200,000.00.

118 SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
119 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
120 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency
121 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain
122 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the
123 Public Assistance Program resulting from the April/May 1991 Flood,
124 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30,
125 2001.....\$ 800,000.00.

126 SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
127 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
128 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund
129 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain
130 administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the
131 cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the 1994 Ice
132 Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
133 June 30, 2001.....\$ 3,205,542.00.

134 SECTION 12. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

135 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
136 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No.
137 372G for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses
138 of the cost of the Nuclear Preparedness Program, for the fiscal
139 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
140\$ 270,000.00.

141 SECTION 13. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
142 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
143 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No.
144 3724 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of providing
145 individual and family disaster relief assistance for personal
146 property losses and damages resulting from disasters declared by
147 the federal government, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
148 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,250,000.00.

149 SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
150 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
151 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund
152 Nos. 3724 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain
153 administrative expenses and federal share of the cost of the
154 Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant
155 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year
156 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
157\$ 21,461,852.00.

158 SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
159 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
160 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency
161 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain
162 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the
163 Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant
164 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year
165 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
166\$ 1,500,000.00.

167 SECTION 16. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
168 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
169 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No.

1703728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses
171and the federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program
172resulting from the December 1998 Ice Storm, for the fiscal year
173beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
174.....\$ 8,500,000.00.

175 SECTION 17. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
176necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
177General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency
178Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain
179administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the
180Public Assistance Program resulting from the December 1998 Ice
181Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
182June 30, 2001.....\$ 500,000.00.

183 SECTION 18. The funds appropriated in Section 6 shall be
184expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and
18543-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of
186matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the
187state.

188 SECTION 19. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by
189this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be
190paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General
191Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon
192warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
193Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
194proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

195 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from
196and after July 1, 2000.
