Based on data provided by the 54Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 55determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 56 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 57act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 58that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 59cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 60 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 61the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 62action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

90 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 91Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for 92sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One 93Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.

94 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 95State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 96credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 97warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
