SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 8necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 9General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 10defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs 11Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 12June 30, 2001.....\$ 3,410,667.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 14necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs 16 Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 17 otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance 18 of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and 19ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 19,902,392.00. 20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 21 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 22be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 23 expenditure:

44 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 45the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 46 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 47 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 48 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 49are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 50 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 51Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 52determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 53 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 54act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 55that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 56 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 57Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 58 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 59action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 60 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 61appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which

HR42/SB3280A.J \*HR42/SB3280A.J\* PAGE 2 62reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 63requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 64such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be e8used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are e9being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 70act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 72Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 73the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 74(\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to 75indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans in the state veterans 76homes. This section and its provisions shall be known and cited 77as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."

SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 79necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 80General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Veterans Affairs 81Board for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of the 82State General Funds, as authorized in Senate Bill 3112, Regular 83Session of 1999, to provide direct care nursing staff at the four 84(4) State Veterans Homes, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 852000, and ending June 30, 2001......\$ 620,000.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the R7provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 88exceed the unexpended balances of June 30, 2000.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 90the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 91credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 92warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 93Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 94proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 95 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 96and after July 1, 2000.
