With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			
36the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
37make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
38Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001			
39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
40are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the			
41Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the			
42Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall			
43determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

If, at the end of any calendar month, 49the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 50action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 51annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 52appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 53reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 54requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be spused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 60 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 61 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 62 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

63the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 64credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 65warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 66Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 67proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

68 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 69 and after July 1, 2000.
