AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 503

By Senator(s) Committee

9 **Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting**
10 **in lieu thereof the following:**

12 SECTION 1. Section 7-1-501, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
13 amended as follows:

14 7-1-501. The commission on uniform state laws shall consist
15 of the following appointed commissioners to the National
16 Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, all of whom
17 shall be members, in good standing, of The Mississippi * * * Bar:
18 two (2) members of the bar appointed by the Governor; a member of
19 the Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; a member of the
20 House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House;
21 any member of the bar who has been elected a life member of the
22 conference; and the Directors of the Mississippi Law Research
23 Institute, and the Senate and House Legislative Services Offices.

24 The commissioners so appointed shall confer and act with the
25 commissioners of other states and territories in the formulation
26 of uniform laws on all subjects. The commissioners shall prepare
27 a report on their recommendations to be submitted to the
28 Legislature for its consideration for adoption.

29 SECTION 2. Section 7-1-503, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
30 amended as follows:

31 7-1-503. Two (2) associate members of the National

32Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, all of whom
33shall be members, in good standing, of The Mississippi Bar, shall
34be appointed to act in accordance with the constitution and bylaws
35of the * * * conference as follows:

36 (a) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1)
37associate member from the * * * staff of the Senate * * *; and

38 (b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
39appoint one (1) associate member from the * * * staff of the
40House * * *.

42 SECTION 3. Section 7-1-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
43amended as follows:

44 7-1-505. The commissioners and associate members shall serve
45until such time as they are removed or their successors are
46appointed by the aforesaid appointing authorities. In the event
47that a commissioner or associate member is unable to attend an
48annual meeting of the conference, the appointing authority shall
49designate a substitute person to attend the meeting.

50 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
51and after July 1, 2000, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2000.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

2CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY APPOINTMENTS OF COMMISSIONERS TO THE
3NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF COMMISSIONERS ON UNIFORM STATE LAWS; TO
4AMEND SECTION 7-1-505, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE
5APPOINTING AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE A SUBSTITUTE TO ATTEND THE
6CONFERENCE'S ANNUAL MEETING, IN THE EVENT THAT A COMMISSIONER OR
7ASSOCIATE MEMBER IS UNABLE TO ATTEND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
