Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 7 in lieu thereof the following:

- 9 SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as 10 Section 97-32-25, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 11 <u>97-32-25.</u> This act shall be known and cited as "Mississippi 12Adult Tobacco Use on Educational Property Act of 2000."
- 13 SECTION 2. The following provision shall be codified as 14 Section 97-32-27, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 15 $\underline{97-32-27.}$ (1) "Adult" means any natural person, age 16 eighteen (18) years old.
- 17 (2) "Minor" means any natural person under the age of 18 eighteen (18) years old.
- 19 (3) "Person" means any natural person.
- 20 (4) "Tobacco product" means any substance that contains 21tobacco including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, 22snuff, smoking tobacco or smokeless tobacco.
- 23 (5) "School property" means any public school building or 24bus, public school campus, grounds, recreational area, athletic 25field, or other property owned, used or operated by any local 26school board, school, or directors for the administration of any 27public educational institution or during a school-related 28activity; provided, however, that the term "school property" shall

29not include any sixteenth section school land or lieu land on 30which is not located a school building, school campus, school 31recreational area or school athletic field. School property shall 32not include property owned or operated by the state institutions 33of higher learning, the public community and junior colleges, or 34vocational-technical complexes where only adult students are in 35attendance.

- 36 SECTION 3. The following provision shall be codified as 37Section 97-32-29, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 38 97-32-29. No person shall use any tobacco product on any 39 school property as defined in Section 2 of this act. Any adult 40 who violates this section shall be subject to a fine and shall be 41 liable as follows: (a) for a first conviction, a fine of Fifty 42 Dollars (\$50.00); (b) for a second conviction, a fine of 43 Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00); and (c) for all subsequent 44 convictions, a fine of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) shall 45 be imposed.
- Any adult found in violation of this section shall be issued 47a citation by the law enforcement agency issuing the citation.

 48 Notification shall include the opportunity for hearing before the 49 appropriate court. For the purposes of this section, "subsequent 50 violations" are those committed on any educational property within 51 the State of Mississippi.
- It is the responsibility of all law enforcement officers and 53 law enforcement agencies of this state to ensure that the 54 provisions of this act are enforced.
- 55 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 56 and after July 1, 2000, and shall stand repealed from and after 57 June 30, 2000.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTIONS 97-32-25, 97-32-27 AND 97-32-29, 2MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TOBACCO BY ADULTS 3ON CERTAIN SCHOOL PROPERTY AND TO PRESCRIBE FINES FOR VIOLATIONS 4THEREOF; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
