AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1449

22 **Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting**
23 **in lieu thereof the following:**

25 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
26 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
27 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
28 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

29 (2) The following highways are designated as state highways
30 and are placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
31 Transportation Commission and such highways, together with the
32 highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other
33 laws adding links to the designated state highway system, are
34 declared to be the state highway system of Mississippi:

35 **Central District - Rankin County:**

36 Mississippi 468 - Beginning at Mississippi 25 in
37 the City of Flowood, thence south to U.S. 80, thence in
38 a southeasterly direction to Whitfield and thence in a
39 northeasterly direction to or near the City of Brandon,
40 all in Rankin County.

41 Mississippi 249 - Beginning at Mississippi 475 in
42 the City of Flowood thence south to U.S. 80 connecting
43 to U.S. 49, all in Rankin County.

44 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation is

45 authorized to construct, maintain, take over and assume
46 jurisdiction of the highways described in this section; provided,
47 however, that in lieu of actually bringing any current roads up to
48 the standards of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, the
49 City of Flowood, the City of Pearl and Rankin County shall provide
50 necessary engineering and rights-of-way, including utility
51 adjustments and movements. Once the necessary engineering and
52 rights-of-way, including utility adjustments and movements are
53 provided for Mississippi 249, the Mississippi Department of
54 Transportation shall provide funds for construction of a four-lane
55 (or five-lane where needed) road from Fourth Street in the City of
56 Flowood to Mississippi 475, a distance of approximately two and
57 two-tenth (2.2) miles.

58 SECTION 2. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
59 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
60 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
61 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

62 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
63 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
64 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
65 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections
66 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the
67 designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
68 highway system of Mississippi:

69 **Southern District - Jones County:**

70 Mississippi 590 - Beginning at Mississippi 11 and extending
71 easterly to Mississippi 29, a distance of approximately 1.3
72 miles.

73 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
74 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
75 highway designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
76 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
77 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.

78 SECTION 3. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
79 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the

80 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
81 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

82 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
83 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
84 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
85 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections
86 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the
87 designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
88 highway system of Mississippi:

89 **Central District - Newton County:**

90 Decatur Street beginning on the north side of the
91 intersection of Third Street and Decatur Street, and
92 proceeding northward to the beginning of state
93 maintenance south of U.S. Highway 80, all within the
94 City of Newton.

95 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
96 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
97 highway designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
98 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
99 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. However, the City of
100 Newton shall not be required to provide to the Mississippi
101 Department of Transportation any right-of-way with a width any
102 greater than the width of right-of-way that existed at the time
103 that the highway segment described in subsection (2) of this
104 section was returned to the jurisdiction of the City of Newton.

105 SECTION 4. The following highways are deleted from the state
106 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
107 Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the
108 governing authorities of the City of Newton:

109 **Central District - Newton County:**

110 (a) That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15
111 beginning south of Interstate 20 at the intersection of
112 Old Mississippi Highway 15 and present Mississippi
113 Highway 15 and extending southwesterly for approximately
114 .033 miles, all within the City of Newton; and

115 (b) That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15 located
116 between U.S. Highway 80 and Decatur Street, all within the
117 City of Newton.

118 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
119 and after July 1, 2000.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN RANKIN
2 COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE
3 JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
4 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE; TO PROVIDE THAT IN LIEU OF BRINGING
5 ANY CURRENT ROADS UP TO THE STANDARDS OF THE MISSISSIPPI
6 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, THE CITY OF FLOWOOD, THE CITY OF
7 PEARL AND RANKIN COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE NECESSARY ENGINEERING AND
8 RIGHTS-OF-WAY, INCLUDING UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS AND MOVEMENTS; TO
9 PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS
10 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR LANES (OR FIVE LANES WHERE NEEDED) OF
11 CERTAIN PORTIONS OF SUCH SEGMENTS ONCE SUCH ENGINEERING AND
12 RIGHTS-OF-WAY ARE PROVIDED; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL
13 SECTION OF HIGHWAY IN JONES COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
14 SYSTEM AND TO PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
15 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL
16 SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY IN NEWTON COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
17 SYSTEM AND TO PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
18 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; TO DELETE TWO SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN
19 NEWTON COUNTY FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO RETURN THEM TO
20 THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF NEWTON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
