SUBSTITUTE 1 FOR AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1449

55 **Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting**
56 **in lieu thereof the following:**

58 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
59 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
60 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
61 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

62 (2) The following highways are designated as state highways
63 and are placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
64 Transportation Commission and such highways, together with the
65 highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other
66 laws adding links to the designated state highway system, are
67 declared to be the state highway system of Mississippi:

68 **Central District - Rankin County:**

69 Beginning at Mississippi 25 in the City of Flowood,
70 thence south to U.S. 80, thence in a southeasterly
71 direction to Whitfield and thence in a northeasterly
72 direction to or near the City of Brandon, all in Rankin
73 County.

74 Beginning at Mississippi 475 in the City of Flowood
75 thence south to U.S. 80 connecting to U.S. 49, all in
76 Rankin County.

77 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation is

78 authorized to construct, maintain, take over and assume
79 jurisdiction of the highways described in this section; provided,
80 however, that in lieu of actually bringing any current roads up to
81 the standards of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, the
82 City of Flowood, the City of Pearl and Rankin County shall provide
83 necessary engineering and rights-of-way, including utility
84 adjustments and movements.

85 SECTION 2. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
86 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
87 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
88 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

89 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
90 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
91 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
92 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections
93 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the
94 designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
95 highway system of Mississippi:

96 **Southern District - Jones County:**

97 Mississippi 590 - Beginning at Mississippi 11 and extending
98 easterly to Mississippi 29, a distance of approximately 1.3
99 miles.

100 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
101 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
102 highway designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
103 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
104 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.

105 SECTION 3. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
106 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
107 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
108 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

109 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
110 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
111 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
112 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections

113 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the
114 designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
115 highway system of Mississippi:

116 **Central District - Newton County:**

117 Decatur Street beginning on the north side of the
118 intersection of Third Street and Decatur Street, and
119 proceeding northward to the beginning of state
120 maintenance south of U.S. Highway 80, all within the
121 City of Newton.

122 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
123 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
124 highway designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
125 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
126 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. However, the City of
127 Newton shall not be required to provide to the Mississippi
128 Department of Transportation any right-of-way with a width any
129 greater than the width of right-of-way that existed at the time
130 that the highway segment described in subsection (2) of this
131 section was returned to the jurisdiction of the City of Newton.

132 SECTION 4. The following highways are deleted from the state
133 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
134 Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the
135 governing authorities of the City of Newton:

136 **Central District - Newton County:**

137 (a) That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15
138 beginning south of Interstate 20 at the intersection of
139 Old Mississippi Highway 15 and present Mississippi
140 Highway 15 and extending southwesterly for approximately
141 .033 miles, all within the City of Newton; and

142 (b) That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15 located
143 between U.S. Highway 80 and Decatur Street, all within the
144 City of Newton.

145 SECTION 5. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
146 shall construct to department design standards, shall perform such
147 reconstruction as may be required to existing highways and shall

148 acquire by gift, purchase or eminent domain proceedings such
149 property as may be necessary to provide four (4) lanes for traffic
150 on and along the following location:

151 **Central District - Lauderdale County:**

152 Old U.S. Highway 45 beginning in the City of Meridian at
153 or near the old Coca Cola Company and extending northerly
154 approximately two (2) miles to just beyond the Town of Marion.

155 (2) The mileage of highway specifically designated in
156 subsection (1) of this section shall be under the jurisdiction of
157 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
158 maintenance and, together with the highways designated in Sections
159 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the state
160 designated highway system, are declared to be the state highway
161 system of Mississippi.

162 SECTION 6. (1) (a) That portion of Mississippi Highway 25
163 from south of Becker, Mississippi, to the Monroe/Itawamba County
164 line shall be known as the "Monroe County Parkway."

165 (b) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
166 erect and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching that
167 portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in this subsection.

168 (2) The portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in
169 subsection (1) of this section shall be constructed by the
170 Mississippi Department of Transportation as a fully-controlled
171 access road. The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
172 authorized to landscape the right-of-way of the portion of
173 Mississippi Highway 25 described in subsection (1) of this
174 section.

175 (3) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect any
176 advertisement or advertising structure within one thousand (1,000)
177 feet of the right-of-way of the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
178 described in subsection (1) of this section. This subsection
179 shall not apply to areas located within a municipality or to
180 signs, displays or devices located on a building which carry only
181 advertisements strictly related to the lawful use of the building.

182 (4) Mississippi Highway 25 shall intersect with U.S. Highway

183 278 at least five hundred (500) feet west of the eastern city
184 limits of the City of Amory as such city limits existed on January
185 1, 2000.

186 (5) The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
187 authorized to construct a four-lane connector road at a point at
188 or near the northern city limits of the City of Amory between old
189 Mississippi Highway 25 and the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
190 described in subsection (1) of this section.

191 SECTION 7. Section 65-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
192 amended as follows:

193 65-3-3. The following highways are * * * designated as state
194 highways and shall be * * * under the jurisdiction of the
195 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
196 maintenance, * * * and such highways, along with all other laws
197 adding links to the designated state highway system, are declared
198 to be the state highway system of Mississippi:

199 Mississippi 1--Begins at Onward, Sharkey County, thence in a
200 westerly direction to Filer, thence in a northerly direction to
201 Mayersville, thence continues from Mississippi 14 approximately
202 mid-way between Mayersville and Rolling Fork to or near
203 Greenville, Rosedale, Sherard and ends at U.S. 49 east of
204 Mississippi River Bridge at Helena, Coahoma County.

205 Mississippi 2--Begins at or near Hickory Flat, Benton County,
206 and extends in a northeasterly direction to or near Blue Mountain,
207 thence continues from or near Ripley to or near Kossuth to U.S. 72
208 west of Corinth, thence from U.S. 45 north of Corinth, Alcorn
209 County, northeasterly to the Mississippi-Tennessee state line.

210 Mississippi 3--Begins at a point on U.S. 61 at or near
211 Redwood, Warren County, and extends in a northeasterly direction
212 to or near Satartia and Yazoo City, thence follows U.S. 49W to or
213 near Inverness, thence in a northeasterly direction to Moorhead,
214 thence north to Sunflower, thence continues along U.S. 49W to
215 Tutwiler, thence in a northeasterly direction to Lambert, Marks,
216 Sledge, Crenshaw, Sarah and Savage to intersect U.S. 61 at or near
217 Lake Cormorant, DeSoto County.

218 Mississippi 4--Begins at or near Fox Island and extends east
219 to or near Tunica, Coahoma County, thence continues from U.S. 61
220 south of Tunica to or near Savage, Strayhorn, Senatobia, Holly
221 Springs, and Ashland, thence continues from Mississippi 5
222 approximately six and one-half miles south of Ashland to or near
223 Ripley, Booneville, Bentonite Mill, Livingstons Store, New Site,
224 and Bay Springs to Mississippi 25 at or near Dennis.

225 Mississippi 5--Begins on Mississippi 178 near Hickory Flat,
226 Benton County, and extends north to Elvis Chapel Church on U.S.
227 72, and thence west on U.S. 72 to Harris Chapel Church and thence
228 northwest to Mississippi 7, Benton County.

229 Mississippi 6--Begins on Mississippi 161 in Clarksdale,
230 thence easterly to Marks, Batesville, Oxford, Pontotoc, Tupelo,
231 thence southerly to Nettleton and ends at or near Amory.

232 Mississippi 7--Begins at or near Belzoni, Humphreys County,
233 and extends in a northeasterly direction to or near Swiftown to
234 U.S. 82 north of Itta Bena, thence continues from or near
235 Greenwood to or near Holcomb, Grenada, Coffeeville, Water Valley,
236 Oxford and Holly Springs to the Mississippi-Tennessee state line
237 northeast of Michigan City, Benton County.

238 Mississippi 8--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near Rosedale,
239 Bolivar County, and extends in an easterly direction to or near
240 Cleveland, Ruleville, Minter City, Philipp and Holcomb, thence
241 continues from or near Grenada to or near Calhoun City, Houston
242 and Aberdeen and ends on U.S. 278 at or near Greenwood Springs,
243 Monroe County.

244 Mississippi 9--Begins at or near Ackerman, Choctaw County,
245 and extends in a northerly direction to or near Eupora,
246 Bellefontaine and Slate Springs to Mississippi 8 south of Calhoun
247 City, thence continues from or near Calhoun City to or near Bruce,
248 Sarepta, Pontotoc and Sherman, thence continuing from U.S. 78
249 northwest of Sherman to, at or near Blue Springs and ending at
250 Mississippi 30 at or near Graham, Union County.

251 Mississippi 9W--Begins on Mississippi 9 north of Bruce,
252 Calhoun County, and extends northerly to or near Banner and Paris

253 to Mississippi 7 at Airport Road south of Markette, Lafayette
254 County.

255 I-10--From the Mississippi-Louisiana state line east of
256 Slidell, Louisiana, to the Mississippi-Alabama state line
257 southwest of Mobile, Alabama.

258 U.S. 11--Begins on I-59 at or near Nicholson, south of
259 Picayune, Pearl River County, and extends in a northeasterly
260 direction to or near Picayune, Poplarville, Hattiesburg, Laurel,
261 Enterprise and Meridian, and thence easterly to the
262 Mississippi-Alabama state line, Lauderdale County.

263 Mississippi 12--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near James,
264 Washington County, thence continuing through LeRoy Percy State
265 Park and extends in an easterly direction to or near Hollandale,
266 Belzoni, Tchula, Lexington, Durant, Kosciusko and Ackerman to a
267 point on U.S. 82 north of Mississippi State University, thence
268 continues from or near Columbus and extends in a northeasterly
269 direction to the Mississippi-Alabama state line, Lowndes County.

270 Mississippi 13--Begins at a point on U.S. 49 at or near
271 Maxie, Forrest County, and extends in a northwesterly direction to
272 or near Lumberton and Columbia, thence continues in a northerly
273 direction to or near Prentiss, Mendenhall, Puckett, Daniel,
274 Polkville, Morton and Lena and ends at a point on Mississippi 16
275 west of Carthage at or near Pine Tree, Leake County.

276 Mississippi 14--Begins at or near Mayersville, Issaquena
277 County, and extends in an easterly direction to or near Rolling
278 Fork, thence continues from U.S. 61 at or near Anquilla to U.S.
279 49W at or near Louise, thence continues from, at or near Ebenezer
280 to or near Goodman, Newport and Zemuly to south of Kosciusko to or
281 near Louisville and Macon ending at the Mississippi-Alabama state
282 line east of Macon, Noxubee County.

283 Mississippi 15--Begins at the intersection of I-10 and I-110,
284 Harrison County, and extends in a northerly direction to or near
285 Beaumont, Laurel, Bay Springs, Newton, Philadelphia, Louisville,
286 Ackerman, Mathiston, Houston, Pontotoc, New Albany, Ripley, Walnut
287 and ends at the Mississippi-Tennessee state line, Tippah County.

288 Mississippi 16--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near the
289 Issaquena-Washington county line, thence in a southeasterly
290 direction to Rolling Fork and extends in a southeasterly direction
291 near Little Sunflower River, thence continues from or near Holly
292 Bluff in a northeasterly direction to U.S. 49W at or near Craig,
293 thence continues from or near Yazoo City to or near Benton to U.S.
294 51 at or near Canton, thence continues to or near Carthage,
295 Philadelphia, Dekalb and Scooba to the Mississippi-Alabama state
296 line east of Scooba, Kemper County.

297 Mississippi 17--Begins in Scott County on designated
298 Mississippi 25, thence northerly to Mississippi 16 near Farmhaven,
299 thence to or near Pickens, Lexington, Carrollton and ends
300 approximately three and one-tenth miles northeast of North
301 Carrollton, Carroll County.

302 Mississippi 18--Begins at or near Grand Gulf, Claiborne
303 County, then to or near Port Gibson and extends in a northeasterly
304 direction to or near Hermanville, Utica and Raymond to an
305 intersection with U.S. 80 at or near Jackson, thence from Brandon
306 continues in a southeasterly direction to or near Raleigh and Bay
307 Springs, thence continues in a northeasterly direction to or near
308 Rose Hill, thence southeast to or near Pachuta, thence east to or
309 near Quitman and ends at the Mississippi-Alabama state line east
310 of Quitman, Clarke County.

311 Mississippi 19--Begins on U.S. 51 at or near West, Holmes
312 County, and extends in a southeasterly direction to or near
313 Kosciusko, Zama, Arlington High School, Yates Crossing,
314 Philadelphia and Meridian, and ends at the Mississippi-Alabama
315 state line southeast of Meridian, Lauderdale County.

316 I-20--From the Mississippi-Louisiana state line at Vicksburg
317 to a point on I-55 in Jackson and from another point on I-55
318 southeast of Jackson to a point on I-59 west of Meridian.

319 Mississippi 21--Begins at a point on Mississippi 35 at or
320 near Forest, Scott County, and runs in a northeasterly direction
321 to or near Sebastopol, Dixon, Neshoba County Fairgrounds,
322 Philadelphia, Bond High School, Preston, Gholson, thence in a

323 northeasterly direction to intersect Mississippi 39 at or near
324 Shugualak, Noxubee County.

325 Mississippi 22--Begins at or near Edwards, Hinds County,
326 thence in a northeasterly direction to or near Flora, thence to a
327 point on U.S. 51 at or near Canton, Madison County.

328 Mississippi 23--Begins on Mississippi 25 at or near
329 Smithville in Monroe County, thence northerly to Tremont, thence
330 to the Mississippi-Alabama state line, Itawamba County, southeast
331 of Golden, Mississippi.

332 Mississippi 24--Begins at or near Fort Adams, Wilkinson
333 County, and extends in an easterly direction to or near Woodville,
334 Centreville, Gloster, Liberty and McComb, Pike County.

335 Mississippi 25--Begins at or near Jackson, Hinds County,
336 thence in a northeasterly direction to or near Carthage,
337 Louisville and Starkville, thence along U.S. 82 to its
338 intersection with U.S. 45A, thence along U.S. 45A to Muldon,
339 thence to or near Aberdeen, Amory, Smithville, to U.S. 78, thence
340 continuing to Belmont, Dennis, Tishomingo, Iuka and to the
341 Mississippi-Tennessee state line north of Cross Roads, Tishomingo
342 County.

343 Mississippi 26--Begins at the Mississippi-Louisiana state
344 line east of Bogalusa, Pearl River County, and extends in an
345 easterly direction to or near Poplarville and Wiggins and ends at
346 or near Lucedale, George County.

347 Mississippi 27--Begins on the Mississippi-Louisiana state
348 line south of Tylertown, Walthall County, and extends northerly to
349 Tylertown, Monticello, Georgetown, Crystal Springs, Utica and ends
350 at or near Vicksburg, Warren County.

351 Mississippi 28--Begins at or near Fayette, Jefferson County,
352 and extends to, at or near Hazlehurst, Georgetown, Pinola, Magee
353 and Taylorsville and ends on U.S. 84 west of Laurel, Jones County.

354 Mississippi 29--Begins at or near Wiggins, Stone County, and
355 extends in a northerly direction to or near Janice, New Augusta,
356 Runnelstown, Ellisville and ends at Mississippi 28 at or near
357 Soso, Jones County.

358 Mississippi 30--Begins at or near Oxford, Lafayette County,
359 and extends in a northeasterly direction to or near New Albany,
360 thence by Keownsville and Pleasant Ridge, thence to a point at or
361 near Wheeler to intersect U.S. 45, thence along U.S. 45 to south
362 of Booneville, thence from U.S. 45 northeasterly to intersect
363 Mississippi 4 and Mississippi 364, thence to Walden's Store, Hills
364 Chapel, Burton and ends at the Natchez Trace Parkway east of
365 Tishomingo, Tishomingo County.

366 Mississippi 32--Begins on Mississippi Highway 1 at or near
367 Perthshire, Bolivar County, and extends east to or near Shelby,
368 thence continues from U.S. 49W at or near Parchman easterly to or
369 near Webb, Charleston, Oakland, Water Valley, Bruce and Houlka,
370 thence continues from Mississippi 15 south of Houlka to or near
371 Van Vleet and Okolona, Chickasaw County.

372 Mississippi 33--Begins at the Mississippi-Louisiana state
373 line, Wilkinson County, and extends northerly to Mississippi 24 at
374 or near Centreville, thence to Gloster to or near Crosby,
375 Knoxville, Roxie and McNair to U.S. 61 south of Fayette, then from
376 or near Fayette northeasterly to or near Red Lick and Pattison to
377 Mississippi 18 at or near Hermanville, Claiborne County.

378 Mississippi 35--Begins at the Mississippi-Louisiana state
379 line, Marion County, south of Sandy Hook and extends in a
380 northerly direction to a point on U.S. 98 at or near Foxworth,
381 thence continues from or near Columbia to or near Bassfield, Lone
382 Star, Mount Olive, Mize, Raleigh, Forest, Carthage, Kosciusko,
383 Vaiden, Holcomb, Charleston and Batesville and ends at or near the
384 Sardis Dam northeast of Batesville, Panola County.

385 Mississippi 37--Begins at a point on U.S. 84, Covington
386 County, south of Hot Coffee and extends in a northerly direction
387 to or near Taylorsville, Center Ridge and ends on Mississippi 35
388 south of Raleigh, Smith County.

389 Mississippi 39--Begins at or near Meridian, Lauderdale
390 County, and extends in a northerly direction to or near DeKalb and
391 ends on U.S. 45 at or near Shuqualak, Noxubee County.

392 Mississippi 41--Begins at or near Pontotoc, Pontotoc County,

393 and extends southeasterly to or near Okolona, thence easterly to
394 U.S. 45 at or near Wren, Monroe County.

395 Mississippi 42--Begins at the Lawrence-Simpson county line
396 northeast of New Hebron and extends to or near New Hebron,
397 Prentiss, Bassfield and Sumrall to U.S. 49 north of Hattiesburg to
398 or near Petal, Runnelstown, Richton, Sand Hill and State Line to
399 the Mississippi-Alabama state line, Wayne County.

400 Mississippi 43--Begins on U.S. 90 west of Bay St. Louis,
401 Hancock County, and extends in a north northwesterly direction to
402 or near Picayune, thence continues from or near Picayune to
403 Mississippi 26 at or near Cross Roads then to Mississippi 13 south
404 of Prentiss west and north to Arm Road in Section 5, Township 6
405 North, Range 20 West, Lawrence County, and proceeds northwesterly
406 for approximately four miles to its intersection with U.S. 84 in
407 Section 24, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, thence continues
408 from, at or near Silver Creek, New Hebron and Pinola to
409 Mississippi 13 southwest of Mendenhall, thence continues from
410 Mississippi 18 at or near Puckett, Cross Roads, Pelahatchie and
411 Pisgah to Mississippi 16 at or near Canton, thence to or near
412 Thomastown, Kosciusko, Shady Grove and Friendship ending at the
413 intersection of Mississippi 407 south of Kilmichael, Montgomery
414 County.

415 Mississippi 44--Begins at or near McComb, Pike County, and
416 extends to or near Pricedale and Jayess to Mississippi 27 east of
417 Jayess, thence continues easterly across the Pearl River to
418 Mississippi 13, Marion County, thence continues from, at or near
419 Columbia to or near Sumrall, Lamar County.

420 U.S. 45--Begins at the Mississippi-Alabama state line at or
421 near the Town of State Line, Greene County, and extends in a
422 northerly direction to or near Waynesboro, Quitman, Meridian,
423 Scooba, Macon, Brooksville, Columbus, Aberdeen, Nettleton,
424 Shannon, Tupelo, Booneville, Corinth and ends at the
425 Mississippi-Tennessee state line north of Corinth, Alcorn County.

426 U.S. 45A--Begins at a point on U.S. 45 at or near
427 Brooksville, Noxubee County, and extends in a northerly direction

428 to or near West Point, Okolona, and ends at a point on U.S. 45 at
429 or near Shannon, Lee County.

430 Mississippi 46--Begins at a point on Mississippi 9 south of
431 Calhoun City, Calhoun County, and extends southeasterly to or near
432 Hohenlinden, Mantee, Montpelier to Mississippi 50 approximately
433 seven miles west of West Point, Clay County.

434 Mississippi 47--Begins at approximately seven miles west of
435 West Point, Clay County, on Mississippi 50 and runs in a northerly
436 direction to intersect with Mississippi 8 at or near Trebloc, and
437 thence north to Buena Vista, Chickasaw County.

438 Mississippi 48--Begins at or near Centreville, Wilkinson
439 County, and extends to Liberty, thence continues from Mississippi
440 24 west of McComb and extends in a southeasterly direction to or
441 near Magnolia, Tylertown and Dexter, thence continues in a
442 southeasterly direction to intersect with Mississippi 35 at Sandy
443 Hook, thence in an easterly direction to or near Lumberton, Lamar
444 County.

445 U.S. 49--Begins at or near Gulfport, Harrison County, and
446 extends in a northerly direction to or near Wiggins, Hattiesburg,
447 Collins, Mendenhall, Jackson and Yazoo City, thence continues from
448 or near Tutwiler to or near Clarksdale, and thence continues from
449 U.S. 61 north of Clarksdale westward to or near the Mississippi
450 River, Coahoma County, near Helena, Arkansas.

451 U.S. 49E--Begins at or near Yazoo City, Yazoo County, and
452 extends in a northerly direction to or near Tchula and Greenwood
453 and ends at or near Tutwiler, Tallahatchie County.

454 U.S. 49W--Begins at or near Yazoo City, Yazoo County, and
455 extends in a northerly direction to or near Belzoni, Indianola and
456 Ruleville and ends at or near Tutwiler, Tallahatchie County.

457 Mississippi 50--Begins at or near Walthall, Webster County,
458 thence easterly to or near Cumberland to Mississippi 15, thence to
459 or near Pheba, Cedar Bluff and West Point to or near junction
460 Mississippi 373 and U.S. 45, then continues from, at or near
461 Columbus on U.S. 82 northeasterly to the Mississippi-Alabama state
462 line, Lowndes County.

463 U.S. 51--Begins at the Mississippi-Louisiana state line at or
464 near Osyka, Pike County, and extends in a northerly direction to
465 or near Magnolia, McComb, Summit, Brookhaven, Hazlehurst, Crystal
466 Springs, Jackson, Canton, Durant, Winona, Grenada, Batesville,
467 Senatobia and Hernando and ends at the Mississippi-Tennessee state
468 line north of Horn Lake, DeSoto County.

469 Mississippi 53--Begins at or near Poplarville, Pearl River

1399 of new U.S. 49W by-pass just south of Isola, thence into Isola to
1400 the north end of U.S. 49 by-pass, Humphreys County.

1401 Mississippi 808--Begins on U.S. 61 in Port Gibson, thence
1402 west to Market Street, thence in a northeasterly direction along
1403 Market Street, thence to U.S. 61 approximately three-fourths mile
1404 north of Port Gibson, all in Claiborne County.

1405 Mississippi 809--Industrial access road from the port and
1406 industrial area to U.S. 82 in Greenville, Washington County.

1407 Mississippi 810--Spur--Begins on U.S. 49W and extends west to

1408 Sunflower, Sunflower County.

1421 Mississippi 818--U.S. 49E Spur--Begins on U.S. 49E and

1426 Mississippi 820--Spur--Begins on U.S. 49W and extends west to

1446 Mississippi 844--U.S. 51 Loop--Begins at I-55 south of
1447 Crystal Springs and extends east across U.S. 51 and north to U.S.
1448 51 in Crystal Springs, all in Covich County.

1449 Mississippi 848--Spur--Begins on U.S. 51 in Beauregard and
1450 extends south on North Street, all in Covich County.

1451 Mississippi 850--A route from the Wesson Campus of
1452 Covich-Lincoln Junior College directly to U.S. 51, all in Covich
1453 County.

1454 Mississippi 852--U.S. 45A Loop--Begins on U.S. 45A in
1455 Brooksville and extends south and east to U.S. 45 at Brooksville,
1456 all in Noxubee County.

1457 Mississippi 853--Begins at the point where Mississippi 16
1458 intersects the gravel road and runs along Sections 35 and 36,
1459 Township 11 North, Range 12 East, Neshoba County, and runs south
1460 along the section lines between Sections 35 and 36 and between

1489 Mississippi 885--Mississippi 16 Connection--Begins on
1490 Mississippi 16 west of Philadelphia and extends northwest to
1491 intersect with Mississippi 15, all in Neshoba County.

1492 Mississippi 886--Begins at the intersection of I-55 in the
1493 Town of Ridgeland thence runs in an easterly direction to U.S. 51
1494 and Jackson Avenue, all in Madison County.

1495 Mississippi 888--Mississippi 13 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1496 13 and extends west at Roosevelt State Park south of Morton, Scott
1497 County.

1498 Mississippi 889--I-20 Connection--Begins at the junction of
1499 U.S. 80 and Adams Street in Chunky, thence north to I-20, all in
1500 Newton County.

1501 Mississippi 890--U.S. 80 Connection--Frontage Road Connection
1502 at Bolton, Hinds County.

1503 Mississippi 892--Mississippi 35 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1504 35 and extends east to Homewood, Scott County.

1505 Mississippi 894--Begins on Mississippi 19 south of
1506 Philadelphia near the Neshoba County Hospital and extends in a
1507 northeasterly direction to intersect present Mississippi 482 about
1508 one and three-tenths miles north of its intersection with
1509 Mississippi 16.

1510 Mississippi 895--Begins at road intersection with U.S. 11 and
1511 80 near the center of Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 17 East,
1512 thence northwesterly, northeasterly and southeasterly through

1513 Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26 to intersection of U.S. 11 and U.S. 80
1514 in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 25,
1515 Township 7 North, Range 17 East, Lauderdale County.

1516 Mississippi 897--Begins on Mississippi 496 in Section 11 and

1528 Mississippi 905--Begins at the intersection of Adams Road

1530 north to Mississippi 24, all in Pike County.

1531 Mississippi 906--Begins on U.S. 51 in Summit and runs in an
1532 easterly direction to intersect Mississippi 570, all in Pike
1533 County.

1534 Mississippi 908--A route providing direct access from the
1535 interchange at I-55 at or near Summit to Southwest Community
1536 College, all in Pike County.

1537 Mississippi 911--Begins on Mississippi 24, now Mississippi 33
1538 in South Gloster, and extends northwest on Kahnville Road, Amite
1539 County.

1540 Mississippi 913--Spur--Begins on Mississippi 24, now
1541 Mississippi 33 in East Gloster, and extends west to Liberty Road,
1542 Amite County.

1543 Mississippi 915--Mississippi 42 and Mississippi 43
1544 Connection--Begins on Jones Street and runs between Mississippi 43
1545 and Mississippi 42, in the Town of New Hebron, Lawrence County.

1546 Mississippi 917--Mississippi 18 Loop--Begins at the
1547 intersection of Mississippi 18 at or near the Sylvarena Masonic

1548 Lodge and makes what is known as the Sylvarena Loop, coming back
1549 into Mississippi 18 at or near the residence of Will Houston, all
1550 in Smith County.

1551 Mississippi 923--Mississippi 584 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1552 584 in the southeast corner of Amite County east of Gillsburg and
1553 extends southeast to the Louisiana-Mississippi state line.

1554 Mississippi 927--Spur--Begins on Mississippi 906 east of
1555 Summit and extends north to Southwest Community College, Pike
1556 County.

1557 Mississippi 928--U.S. 65 Spur--Begins on U.S. 65 in Natchez
1558 and extends north on Homochitto Street, Adams County.

1559 Mississippi 930 and 932--Begin on U.S. 61 North in Adams
1560 County, in the vicinity of the weighing scales and proceed
1561 therefrom to the intersection of Melrose Avenue and East Franklin
1562 Street.

1563 Mississippi 937--U.S. 84 Spur--Begins on U.S. 84 in south
1564 Prentiss and extends north on Columbia Avenue to the railroad
1565 crossing, all in Jefferson Davis County.

1566 Mississippi 938--Begins at the northwest corner of new
1567 Mississippi Transportation Department District Office site and
1568 extends easterly to U.S. 51 approximately forty-five
1569 one-hundredths mile north of the north corporate limits of the
1570 City of McComb, Pike County.

1571 Mississippi 946--Mississippi 24 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1572 24, now Mississippi 33, Amite County, and extends northwest to
1573 Centreville, Wilkinson County.

1574 Mississippi 952--Mississippi 513 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1575 513 and extends north to U.S. 11 in Enterprise, Clarke County.

1576 Mississippi 967--U.S. 49 Spur--Begins on Mississippi 42 in
1577 north Hattiesburg and extends south on Main Street, all in Forrest
1578 County.

1579 Mississippi 969--Spur--Begins on U.S. 49 approximately 2.84
1580 miles south of U.S. 11, and extends north on Edwards Street
1581 approximately .83 miles, all in Hattiesburg, Forrest County.

1582 Mississippi 975--Begins on U.S. 90 at Cowan Road in Gulfport,

1583 thence in a northerly direction along Cowan and Lorraine Roads to
1584 I-10, thence in a northwesterly direction to North Swan Road and
1585 ends on U.S. 49 at or near Lyman for a distance of approximately
1586 12 miles, all in Harrison County.

1587 Mississippi 977--A central Harrison County connector from
1588 I-10 to U.S. 90 in the vicinity of Canal Road to the Mississippi
1589 State Port at Gulfport.

1590 Mississippi 979--An east Harrison County connector from U.S.
1591 90 to I-10 to be located between the Cowan-Lorraine Road
1592 interchange and the I-110 interchange, thence northerly to
1593 relocated/reconstructed Mississippi 67.

1595 north to relocated/reconstructed Mississippi 67, thence
1596 northwesterly to relocated Mississippi 67 at or near U.S. 49, all
1597 in Harrison County.

1598 Mississippi 991--Spur, also known as Singing River Island
1599 Causeway--extends south to Naval Station, all in Jackson County.

1600 Mississippi 992--Mississippi 43 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1601 43 northwest of Picayune and extends south to Picayune, Pearl
1602 River County.

1603 Mississippi 993--Begins at Litton Industries, Inc., between
1604 West Pascagoula River and East Pascagoula River in the City of
1605 Pascagoula and extends north to U.S. 90, all in Jackson County.

1606 Mississippi 994--Mississippi 613 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1607 613 in Moss Point and extends east to U.S. 90 at Orange Grove,
1608 Jackson County.

1609 SECTION 8. The following shall be codified as Section
1610 65-3-71.51, Mississippi Code of 1972:

1611 65-3-71.51. (1) Mississippi 908, a route providing direct
1612 access from the interchange at I-55 at or near Summit to Southwest
1613 Community College, is designated and shall be known as the
1614 "Hershal L. Grady Memorial Highway."

1615 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
1616 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching such highway.

1617 SECTION 9. Sections 65-3-5, 65-3-7, 65-3-9, 65-3-11,

1618 65-3-13, 65-3-15, 65-3-17, 65-3-19, 65-3-21, 65-3-23, 65-3-25,
1619 65-3-27, 65-3-33, 65-3-37, 65-3-72, 65-3-73, 65-3-74, 65-3-75,
1620 65-3-76, 65-3-77, 65-3-78, 65-3-79, 65-3-81, 65-3-83, 65-3-85,
1621 65-3-87, 65-3-89, 65-3-91, 65-3-93, 65-3-95, 65-3-101, 65-3-103,
1622 65-3-105, 65-3-107, 65-3-109, 65-3-111, 65-3-113, 65-3-115,
1623 65-3-117, 65-3-119, 65-3-121, 65-3-123, 65-3-125, 65-3-127,
1624 65-3-129 and 65-3-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, which add and
1625 delete certain highway segments to and from the designated state
1626 highway system, are repealed.

1627 SECTION 10. Section 63-9-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
1628 amended as follows:

1629 63-9-11. (1) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate
1630 any of the provisions of Chapter 3, 5 or 7 of this title, unless
1631 such violation is by such chapters or other law of this state
1632 declared to be a felony.

1633 (2) Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for a violation
1634 of any of the provisions of such chapters for which another
1635 penalty is not provided shall for first conviction thereof be
1636 punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
1637 or by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days; for a second
1638 such conviction within one (1) year thereafter such person shall
1639 be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars
1640 (\$200.00) or by imprisonment for not more than twenty (20) days or
1641 by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent
1642 conviction within one (1) year after the first conviction such
1643 person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred
1644 Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment for not more than six (6)
1645 months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

1646 (3) Whenever, in a misdemeanor case, a person is convicted
1647 of violating any of the provisions of Chapter 3, 5 or 7 of this
1648 title, the court imposing sentence may order the defendant to
1649 attend and participate in a court-approved traffic safety violator
1650 school, in addition to any other penalty authorized by law.

1651 (4) If a person pleads not guilty to a misdemeanor offense
1652 under any of the provisions of Chapter 3, 5 or 7 of this title but

1653 is convicted, and the person has not received a prior conviction
1654 under said chapters within three (3) years of the date of the
1655 alleged offense, the court shall suspend the sentence for such
1656 offense to allow the defendant ninety (90) days to successfully
1657 complete a court-approved traffic safety violator school at his
1658 own cost. Upon successful completion by the defendant of the
1659 course, the court shall set the conviction aside, dismiss the
1660 prosecution and direct that the case be closed. The court on its
1661 own motion shall expunge the record of the conviction, and the
1662 only record maintained thereafter shall be the nonpublic record
1663 required under Section 63-9-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, solely
1664 for use by the courts in determining an offender's eligibility
1665 under this section as a first-time offender.

1666 (5) If all of the conditions set forth in paragraphs (a)
1667 through (f) of this subsection are met, the court may withhold
1668 acceptance of the plea and defer sentencing in order to allow the
1669 defendant ninety (90) days to successfully complete a
1670 court-approved traffic safety violator school at his own cost,
1671 whereupon the court shall dismiss the prosecution and direct that
1672 the case be closed. The only record maintained thereafter shall
1673 be the nonpublic record required under Section 63-9-17,
1674 Mississippi Code of 1972, solely for use by the courts in
1675 determining eligibility as a first-time offender under this
1676 section:

1677 (a) The person, except as provided in paragraph (f),
1678 enters a plea in person or in writing of nolo contendere or guilty
1679 and presents to the court an oral request or a written request, in
1680 person or by mail postmarked on or before the appearance date on
1681 the citation, to attend a court-approved traffic safety violator
1682 school.

1683 (b) The court enters judgment on the defendant's plea
1684 of nolo contendere or guilty at the time the plea is made, but
1685 defers the imposition or the execution of the whole or any part of
1686 the sentence for ninety (90) days.

1687 (c) The defendant has a valid Mississippi driver's

1688 license or permit.

1689 (d) The defendant's public and nonpublic driving record
1690 as maintained by the Department of Public Safety does not indicate
1691 successful completion of a driver's education, training or
1692 improvement course under this section within the three (3) years
1693 of the date of the alleged offense.

1694 (e) The defendant files an affidavit with the court
1695 stating that this is his first conviction in more than three (3)
1696 years, he is not in the process of taking a course under this
1697 section and he has not completed a course under this section that
1698 is not yet reflected on his driving record.

1699 (f) The offense charged is for a misdemeanor offense
1700 under Chapter 3, 5 or 7 of this title.

1701 (6) An out-of-state resident may be allowed to complete a
1702 substantially similar program in his home state, province or
1703 country provided paragraphs (a), (b), (d), (e) and (f) of
1704 subsection (5) of this section are satisfied, and provided that
1705 the defendant has a valid driver's license or permit from that
1706 home jurisdiction.

1707 SECTION 11. Section 63-9-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
1708 amended as follows:

1709 63-9-17. (1) Every court shall keep a full record of the
1710 proceedings of every case in which a person is charged with any
1711 violation of law regulating the operation of vehicles on the
1712 highways, streets or roads of this state.

1713 (2) Unless otherwise sooner required by law, within
1714 forty-five (45) days after the conviction of a person upon a
1715 charge of violating any law regulating the operation of vehicles
1716 on the highways, streets or roads of this state, every * * * court
1717 in which such conviction was had shall prepare and immediately
1718 forward to the Department of Public Safety an abstract of the
1719 record of said court covering the case in which said person was so
1720 convicted, which abstract must be certified by the person so
1721 authorized to prepare the same to be true and correct.

1722 (3) Said abstract must be made upon a form approved by the

1723 Department of Public Safety, and shall include the name and
1724 address of the party charged, the registration number of the
1725 vehicle involved, the nature of the offense, the date of hearing,
1726 the plea, the judgment, and if the fine was satisfied by
1727 prepayment or appearance bond forfeiture, and the amount of the
1728 fine or forfeiture, as the case may be.

1729 (4) Every * * * court shall also forward a like report to
1730 the Department of Public Safety upon the conviction of any person
1731 of manslaughter or other felony in the commission of which a
1732 vehicle was used.

1733 (5) Every court shall also forward a like report to the
1734 Department of Public Safety upon the satisfactory completion by
1735 any defendant of a court-approved traffic safety violator school
1736 under subsection (4) or (5) of Section 63-9-11, Mississippi Code
1737 of 1972, and the department shall make and maintain a private,
1738 nonpublic record to be kept for a period of three (3) years. The
1739 record shall be solely for the use of the courts in determining
1740 eligibility under Section 63-9-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, as a
1741 first-time offender, and shall not constitute a criminal record
1742 for the purpose of private or administrative inquiry. Reports
1743 forwarded to the Department of Public Safety under this subsection
1744 shall be exempt from the provisions of the Mississippi Public
1745 Records Act of 1983.

1746 (6) The failure by refusal or neglect of any such judicial
1747 officer to comply with any of the requirements of this section
1748 shall constitute misconduct in office and shall be grounds for
1749 removal therefrom.

1750 (7) The Department of Public Safety shall keep copies of all
1751 abstracts received hereunder for a period of three (3) years at
1752 its main office and the same shall be open to public inspection
1753 during reasonable business hours.

1754 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
1755 and after July 1, 2000.
