5 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 6in lieu thereof the following:

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- SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 9necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 10 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 11defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History 12 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 8,515,778.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 15 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 16 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of 17 Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 18 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the 19 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 20 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 23 Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 24 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 25 expenditure:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
47the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
48 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
49 Services for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
51are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
52Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
53Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
54determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
55appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
56act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
57that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
58cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
59 Services when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
60the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
61action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
62annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"

- 63appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 64reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 65requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be roused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are leading used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this roughly and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The Mississippi Department of Archives and 74History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 75donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 76organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 77operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 78contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 79regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 80manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 81 SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 82Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 83maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 84the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 85charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 86State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 87Archives and History.
- SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 89 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 90 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 91 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

- This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
- 110the expenditure of State General Funds for the acquisition,
- 111 installation and implementation of an electronic cataloging system
- 112 and public access catalog, and for related staff training needs.
- 113 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the
- 114provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended
- 115 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.
- 116 SECTION 9. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Six Hundred
- 117Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) is provided to the Department of
- 118 Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as
- 119 created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help
- 120 support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.
- 121 SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 122necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State
- 123General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
- 124Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the
- 125 expenditure of the State General Funds, as authorized in House
- 126Bill 1628, Regular Session of 1999, for restoring the Beulah
- 127Cemetery, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
- 129 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
- 130the expenditure of State General Funds to restore the historic
- 131Beulah Cemetery, a National Register of Historic Places property
- 132in Vicksburg, Mississippi.

- Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 134 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 135 exceed the unexpended balances of June 30, 2000.
- Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 151provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 152exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.
- SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 154the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 155credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 156warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 157Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 158proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 159 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 160 and after July 1, 2000.
