AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

House Bill NO. 1614

By Senator(s) Committee

6 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
7 in lieu thereof the following:

9 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
10 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
11 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
12 salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys and assistant
13 district attorneys of the state and paying office expenses of
14 district attorneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and
15 ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 12,902,483.00.

16 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
17 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
18 expended for the respective purposes:

19 (a) Salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys,
20 assistant district attorneys and criminal investigators of the
21 state:

22 Salaries.....\$11,684,206.00
23 Travel Expenses..... 415,167.00
24 Tort Claims Assessment.....\$ 35,110.00

25 None of the funds authorized in this section shall be used to
26 reimburse district attorneys or their staff for taxable meals
27 incurred within their geographical district.

28 (b) Office expenses of district attorneys as authorized

29 by Section 25-31-8, Mississippi Code of 1972.....
30\$ 768,000.00.

31 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1,
32 Eighty-five Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$85,216.00) is
33 provided to fund salary and office expense for one (1) full-time
34 legal assistant in the Sixth Circuit Court District as authorized
35 in Section 25-31-5(2)(f), Mississippi Code of 1972.

36 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
37 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
38 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
39 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
40 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
41 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

42 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
43 and after July 1, 2000.
