With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			
37the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001			
40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
41are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the			
42Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the			
43Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall			
44determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 86 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
