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SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 9necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 10 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 11 maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying 12out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, 13 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 142001.....\$ 10,849,745.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 15 16necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 17 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 18Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds 19 collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the 20 purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal 21 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 22.....\$ 2,708,325.00. 23 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 24 Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 25 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 26 expenditure:

47 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 48 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 49 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 50 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 51 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 52are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 53Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 54Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 55determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 56 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 57act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 58that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 59 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 60 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 61the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 62action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

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No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be rused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems 75 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid 76 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 77 31 and June 30.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 79Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred 80Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the 81Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 82and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

83 SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 84Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 85the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 86in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 87intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 88this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 89performance measures provided below:

108 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 109set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 110agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 111Committee for Fiscal Year 2001.

112 SECTION 6. With the funds provided herein, it is the 113 intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library 114 Commission shall provide Twenty-five Thousand Dollars 115 (\$25,000.00) to the family resource grants.

116 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 117Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 118escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 119Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 120regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 121manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

122 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 123the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 124credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 125warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 126Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 127proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 128 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 129and after July 1, 2000.
