With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 172 173the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 174 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 175 Services for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 176 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 177are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 178Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 179Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 180 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 181appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 182act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 183that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 184cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 185 Services " when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 186the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 187action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 188 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 189 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 190 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 191 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 192 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive 194Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer 195between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 196 positions not to exceed five percent (5%) of the receiving office 197in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 198accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, 199 Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 200 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 201 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of

202Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month 203prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the 204intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 205provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and 206that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 207alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 208 in the original appropriations made under this act.

- 209 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 210 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 211being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 212act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 213 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 214appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 215 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 216 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 217Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 218 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 219 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
- SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 222 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 223 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 224Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 225any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 226 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
- It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 228 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 229 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 230 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 231the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 232credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 233 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 234Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 235 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
