35 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 41Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 48 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 49the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 50action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 51annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 52appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 53reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 54requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be spused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 60 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 61 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 62 SECTION 3. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except

63 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
64 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
65 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
66 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
67 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
68 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

- SECTION 4. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 70be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 71or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 72 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 and after July 1, 2000.
