39 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
41 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
42Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
44are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
45Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
46Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
47determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
48appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
49act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
50that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
51cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
52Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
53the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
54action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
55annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
56appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
57reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
58requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
59 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
61the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

- 66 SECTION 3. Of the funds authorized and approved for 67 expenditure herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that 68 not less than twenty-five percent (25%) of all revenues obtained 69 from the sale of timber on the Pearl River Valley Supply District 70 property shall be used for the promotion and enhancement of 71 wildlife on the Pearl River Valley Supply District property. The 72 promotion and enhancement of wildlife and the expenditure of these 73 funds shall be under the supervision of and at the discretion of 74 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks.
- 75 SECTION 4. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except 76 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which 77 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, 78 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the 79 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent 80(1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 81 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 82 SECTION 5. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 83be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 84or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with 85the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
- 86 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after July 1, 2000.
