- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 36the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be salused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are special funds which are used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 40 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 3. In the event of a natural disaster or other major 42 catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits 43 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore 44 port facilities, the Port Authority and the Department of Economic 45 and Community Development, with the approval of the Department of 46 Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under 47 Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. However, 48 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of 49 such funds is shown.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 51Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized 52to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with 53applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 54Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 55federal funds.
- 56 SECTION 5. The money appropriated under the provisions of 57Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper 58person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 59 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 60 and after July 1, 2000.
