22	Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, he retired in 1995 from U.S. Motors in Philadelphia,

Mississippi, where he served as a storekeeper in the parts area,

and is currently employed as a security guard at U.S. Motors; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson has a long history of church and
