SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 4  
(As Adopted by Senate)

1 A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND WILBERT BROOKS JACKSON FOR HIS  
2 LONGTIME DEDICATED SERVICE TO OAK GROVE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH.

3 WHEREAS, Wilbert Brooks Jackson was born July 30, 1925, in  
4 Kemper County, Mississippi, to Wilbert Jackson, Jr. and the former  
5 Lester Triplett; and

6 WHEREAS, married to the former Lynette Roberts of DeKalb,  
7 Mississippi, they have three children who all reside in Preston,  
8 Mississippi; and

9 WHEREAS, their eldest child, Charles R. Jackson, is coach of  
10 the boys' basketball team at Kemper County High School at DeKalb,  
11 Mississippi, and coached the 1992 State Champion Boys team from  
12 Kemper County; their second child, Wilbert Bernard Jackson, is an  
13 electrical technician for Weyerhaeuser in Columbus, Mississippi;  
14 and their youngest child, Crystal Jackson Benn, is a high school  
15 counselor for the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson served in the United States military for  
17 over four years, reaching the rank of Sergeant First Class during  
18 World War II; and

19 WHEREAS, he was one of the first African-American government  
20 contractors in Kemper County, serving as a Turf Builder and Cotton  
21 Acreage Surveyor, and was also a bus driver for the Kemper County  
22 Public Schools; and

23 WHEREAS, he retired in 1995 from U.S. Motors in Philadelphia,  
24 Mississippi, where he served as a storekeeper in the parts area,  
25 and is currently employed as a security guard at U.S. Motors; and

26 WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson has a long history of church and

27 community service; and

28 WHEREAS, he served on the Kemper County FHA Board for many  
29 years, is a Life Member of the NAACP and is serving his second  
30 term on the Board of Directors of the Neshoba County Gin  
31 Association; and

32 WHEREAS, a longtime member of Oak Grove Missionary Baptist  
33 Church, he served as Superintendent of Sunday School for over 50  
34 years and has been a deacon since 1948; he also served as  
35 Treasurer of the Sunday School Congress for the Mt. Olive  
36 District; and currently serves as Program Chairman of the  
37 Ministers' and Deacons' Council of the Mt. Olive District; and

38 WHEREAS, Wilbert Brooks Jackson has been a steadfast  
39 supporter and hero of the faith at Oak Grove Missionary Baptist  
40 Church for many years:

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
42 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend Wilbert Brooks Jackson for  
43 his many years of dedicated service to Oak Grove Missionary
