HOUSE BILL NO. 51

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A BRIEF PERIOD OF QUIET REFLECTION TO BE 2 CONDUCTED DAILY BY TEACHERS IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL CLASSROOM; AND 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) In each public school classroom, the teacher in charge shall conduct a brief period of quiet reflection for not more than sixty (60) seconds at the opening of school upon every school day, with the participation of all the pupils therein assembled.

10 (2) The moment of quiet reflection authorized by subsection 11 (1) of this section is not intended to be and may not be conducted 12 as a religious service or exercise but is considered an 13 opportunity for a moment of silent reflection on the anticipated 14 activities of the day.

15 (3) Subsections (1) and (2) of this section may not be 16 deemed to prohibit student initiated voluntary prayers that are 17 nonsectarian or nonproselytizing in nature at school or school 18 related events.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
