COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 52

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ESTABLISH A 1 VOCATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM THROUGH WHICH STUDENTS MAY 2 3 RECEIVE CREDITS TOWARD GRADUATION FOR VOCATIONAL EXPERIENCE; TO 4 PROVIDE THAT STUDENTS IN THE VOCATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM SHALL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE CORE CURRICULUM DEFINED BY THE 5 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND MAY EARN ADDITIONAL CREDITS FOR 6 7 PARTICIPATION IN THE VOCATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP; AND FOR RELATED 8 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) The school board of a local school district, 10 11 in its discretion, may establish and implement a vocational apprenticeship program in the high schools in that district 12 through which students may earn high school units for vocational 13 experience as an alternative to those high school units required 14 by the school district in addition to the core curriculum defined 15 by the State Board of Education. The purpose of a vocational 16 apprenticeship program established pursuant to this section shall 17 be to provide those students with skills and training that will 18 lead to gainful employment in a trade or other specialized 19 vocation. 20

(2) Students who participate in the vocational 21 apprenticeship program shall be required to complete all high 22 school units comprising the core curriculum, as defined by the 23 State Board of Education. In addition, a student in the 24 vocational apprenticeship program may be awarded credit for an 25 additional eight (8) high school units earned through the 26 vocational apprenticeship program, which units shall apply toward, 27 28 and must be recognized by the State Board of Education in fulfillment of, the local school district's graduation 29 requirements. Units may be awarded in the vocational 30

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apprenticeship program, whereby a student gains actual work experience through employment in a job approved by the local school district. The local school district shall adopt policies governing the participation of students in the vocational apprenticeship program.

38 entitled to a diploma evidencing graduation from a high school in
39 Mississippi.

40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2001.
