HOUSE BILL NO. 79

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-9-148, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO JUSTIFY SALARY INCREASES THAT ARE
INCONSISTENT WITH THE VARIABLE COMPENSATION PLAN AND TO REQUIRE
THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD TO REPORT TO CERTAIN LEGISLATIVE
COMMITTEES ON SUCH INCREASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 25-9-148, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

(1) Before September 1 * * * of every year * * *, 9 25-9-148. the State Personnel Board shall prepare a written report to be 10 submitted to the Chairmen of the House of Representatives 11 Appropriations and Fees and Salaries of Public Officers 12 Committees, the Chairmen of the Senate Appropriations and Fees, 13 14 Salaries and Administration Committees and the Legislative Budget Office specifically describing every increase in compensation, 15 other than salary increases authorized by the Legislature, or 16 additional compensation that was awarded to any state officer, 17 administrator, executive head, employee or employees during the 18 next preceding fiscal year. For each increase or additional 19 compensation awarded, the report shall include no less than the 20 following information: the annual salary of the officer, 21 22 administrator, executive head or employee before the increase; the total amount of the increase or additional compensation; the 23 justification for the increase or additional compensation; the 24 effective date of the increase or additional compensation; and the 25 source of the additional compensation, including federal or 26 27 private funds.

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An agency that grants a salary increase to any state 28 (2) 29 officer, administrator, executive head, employee or employees 30 which is inconsistent with the Colonel Guy Groff State Variable Compensation Plan shall submit a justification for such increase 31 32 to the State Personnel Board before the expiration of the fiscal year during which the increase is granted. The State Personnel 33 Board shall submit a written report of all such increases, 34 including an analysis by the board of the justifications, to the 35 Chairmen of the House of Representatives Appropriations and Fees 36 and Salaries of Public Officers Committees, the Chairmen of the 37 Senate Appropriations and Fees, Salaries and Administration 38 Committees and the Legislative Budget Office before July 15 of the 39 next succeeding fiscal year. 40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2001. 42
