## HOUSE BILL NO. 249

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1
- TO REMOVE THE ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED TO BE PAID BY VOLUNTEER 2
- 3 FIREFIGHTERS IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE FIREFIGHTER
- 4 LICENSE TAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 27-19-56.1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 8
- 9 firefighter, including a career firefighter, a volunteer
- firefighter or an industrial firefighter, employed by or in the 10
- service of any municipality, county, fire district, state agency 11
- or industry in the state who is a resident of this state, or who 12
- is a retired firefighter who is a resident of this state, upon 13
- payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes 14
- and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 15
- passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 16
- and upon payment of any additional fee required under subsection 17
- (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for 18
- each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person 19
- as a firefighter or retired firefighter. The distinctive license 20
- tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be agreed 21
- upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Firefighters 22
- Association and the State Tax Commission, shall consist of such 23
- letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish 24
- each license tag and may, in the discretion of the State Tax 25

- 26 Commission, display the county name.
- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 27
- by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 28

- 29 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such
- 30 distinctive license tags (a) shall present to the issuing official
- 31 proof of their employment or service as a firefighter by
- 32 presentation of the applicant's official firefighter
- 33 identification card or a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 34 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 35 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry by or for
- 36 whom the applicant is employed or serves as a firefighter; or (b)
- 37 shall present proof that they are a retired firefighter by
- 38 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 39 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 40 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry from whom
- 41 the firefighter retired. The application and any additional fee
- 42 imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three percent
- 43 (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 44 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 45 prescribed by the commission. The portion of any additional fee
- 46 required to be imposed under subsection (3) of this section that
- 47 is retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
- 48 county general fund.
- 49 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 50 after July 1, 2001, any person, except a volunteer firefighter,
- 51 <u>who</u> appl<u>ies</u> for a distinctive license tag under this section shall
- 52 pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
- 53 each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which
- 54 shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional
- 55 fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the
- 56 vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due
- 57 and payable at the time the original application is made for a
- 58 distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually
- 59 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains
- 60 the distinctive license tag. <u>Volunteer firefighters shall be</u>
- 61 exempt from the payment of an additional fee. If the owner does

- 62 not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, or if the owner
- 63 retires or resigns from or otherwise vacates his employment or
- 64 service as a firefighter, he must surrender it to the local county
- 65 tax collector.
- 66 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 67 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 68 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 69 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of
- 70 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an
- 71 amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees
- 72 collected from the issuance of such distinctive license tags under
- 73 this section to the State General Fund, and the remainder of such
- 74 additional fees collected shall be distributed by the State
- 75 Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 76 7-9-70.
- 77 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 78 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 79 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 80 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 81 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 82 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 83 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 84 tag.
- 85 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 86 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 87 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 88 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 89 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 90 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 91 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 92 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 93 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 94 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

95	(7) In lieu of the distinctive license tag authorized under
96	subsections (1) through (6) of this section, any person who
97	presents proof of his employment or service as a firefighter in
98	the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section, may be
99	issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor vehicle
100	registered in his name identifying such person as a firefighter.
101	The distinctive license tag decal shall be of such size, color and
102	design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the
103	Mississippi Firefighters Association and the State Tax Commission;
104	however, the State Tax Commission shall have final approval of the
105	size, color and design. The distinctive license tag decals shall
106	be prepared and sold at Two Dollars (\$2.00) each through the
107	Mississippi Firefighters Training Academy; however, volunteer
108	firefighters shall be exempt from the payment of such fee.
109	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
110	and after July 1, 2001.
