HOUSE BILL NO. 305

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO INCREASE THE PER DIEM COMPENSATION AUTHORIZED TO BE PAID BY
- 3 COUNTIES TO BAILIFFS FROM \$40.00 TO \$60.00; AND FOR RELATED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court,
- 9 or a court of eminent domain may, in the judge's discretion, by
- 10 order entered on the minutes of the court, allow the sheriff
- 11 riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge,
- 12 not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed
- 13 shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance
- of a warrant therefor in the amount of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for
- 15 each day, or part thereof, for which he serves as bailiff when the
- 16 court is in session. No full-time deputy sheriff shall be paid as
- 17 a riding bailiff of any court. County court judges shall be
- 18 limited to one (1) bailiff per each court day.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after October 1, 2001.
