HOUSE BILL NO. 337

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-14-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 EXEMPT LICENSED AUDIOLOGISTS FROM THE HEARING AID SPECIALISTS
3 LICENSURE LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. Section 73-14-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 73-14-5. (1) This chapter is not intended to prevent any
8 person from engaging in the practice of measuring human hearing
9 for the purpose of selection of hearing aids, provided such person
10 or organization employing such person does not sell hearing aids
11 or accessories thereto, except in the case of ear molds to be used
12 only for the purpose of audiologic evaluation.

13 (2) This chapter shall not apply to any physician or surgeon
14 licensed by the State of Mississippi or to any audiologist
15 licensed under Section 73-38-1 et seq.

16 (3) This chapter does not apply to a person while he is
17 engaged in the fitting of hearing aids, provided it is part of the
18 academic curriculum of an accredited institution of higher
19 education or part of a program conducted by a public tax-supported
20 institution or agency or nonprofit organization, unless such
21 person or institution or agency sells hearing aids, and/or
22 accessories, except ear molds.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
24 and after July 1, 2001.
