HOUSE BILL NO. 343

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO REGISTER HOME 2 SCHOOL STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, the phrase "home school student" means a child taught by private teachers, parents, guardians or custodians in a legitimate home instruction program as defined in the Mississippi Compulsory School Attendance Law (Section 37-13-91).

(2) Upon the request of a parent, guardian or legal 10 custodian of a home school student, the local school board may 11 register the student in a public school for purposes of 12 13 participating in any extracurricular activities available to students in the home school student's grade. A home school 14 15 student applying for registration in a public school to participate in an extracurricular activity or activities must 16 reside within the attendance boundaries of the school in which the 17 student is seeking registration. A request for registration in a 18 public school under this section must be submitted by the parent, 19 quardian or legal custodian before May 1 for participation in the 20 21 extracurricular activity in the following school year.

(3) This section may not be construed to require any home
school student to register with any school district for
extracurricular activity purposes.

25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after July 1, 2001.
