## HOUSE BILL NO. 402

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-23-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, CLARIFY THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY EXPEND FUNDS NMAKING REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR TEACHERS WITH VARIOUS DISABILITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE DISABILITY OF VISUAL IMPAIRMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-23-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

37-23-13. (1) The school board of any school district 9 is \* \* \* authorized to comply with the provisions of the Federal 10 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 USCS Sections 11 12101-12213 (West Supp. 1991)) by making reasonable accommodations 12 to the known physical or mental limitations of an otherwise 13 14 qualified individual with a disability who is an applicant or employee, unless the school board can demonstrate that the 15 accommodation would impose an undue hardship on the operation of 16 the school. The school board of any such school district 17 determining that such accommodation is required and reasonable may 18 apply, by resolution spread upon its minutes, \* \* \* to the State 19 Department of Education for funds to defray the cost of making the 20 reasonable accommodations, as determined by the school board to be 21 22 in the best interest of the individual teacher, for \* \* \* teachers with disabilities in compliance with the federal law. 23

(2) The State Department of Education, within the
availability of funds appropriated for such purpose, may expend
funds for the purpose of defraying the expenses of school
districts in making the reasonable accommodations, as determined
by the school board to be in the best interest of the individual

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teacher, for \* \* \* teachers with a disability under the \* \* \*
Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, with the approval of the
State Board of Education. The department shall <u>prescribe</u>, by
regulation, \* \* \* a method and necessary forms for the purpose of
school districts' applications for funds as authorized <u>in this</u>
<u>section</u>.

35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2001.
