HOUSE BILL NO. 428

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF THE MISSISSIPPI CIVIL 2 RIGHTS MUSEUM; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI CIVIL RIGHTS MUSEUM 3 SHALL BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF 4 ARCHIVES AND HISTORY AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF 5 THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY REGARDING THE MUSEUM; TO 6 CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI CIVIL RIGHTS MUSEUM FUND"; AND FOR RELATED 7 PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The Legislature recognizes a need for a civil 9 10 rights museum in Mississippi to promote the educational and social development of Mississippians and to honor those persons who have 11 made significant contributions toward the advancement of civil 12 rights in Mississippi and the United States. The Legislature 13 further recognizes that a civil rights museum would be of great 14 15 economic and cultural importance to Mississippi.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A facility to house the Mississippi Civil 17 Rights Museum shall be located on state property at a location 18 recommended by the Board of Trustees of the Department of Archives 19 and History.

(2) (a) The museum shall be under the supervision and
control of the Board of Trustees of the Department of Archives and
History.

(b) The duties and powers of the Board of Trustees of the Department of Archives and History shall include, in addition to other duties and powers granted or prescribed by law, the following:

27 (i) To promulgate rules and regulations governing28 the operation of the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum;

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(ii) To promulgate rules and regulations governing 29 the acquisition of furniture and furnishings, including but not 30 limited to paintings and objects of art and the acquisition of 31 32 documents for the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum.

33 (C) To promote the donation, bequest, devise or loaning 34 of money or property, real or personal, from any agency of the United States, state or local government, any person, firm, 35 corporation, association or group, for the purpose of the 36 operation, administration and maintenance of the Mississippi Civil 37 38 Rights Museum;

39 (d) To acquire, preserve, restore or operate any real or personal property deemed significant for historical, 40 41 architectural or cultural reasons, to expend funds for such purposes, to enter into contracts or agreements with any agency of 42 the United States or any person, firm, corporation or association 43 for the purpose of the operation, administration and maintenance 44 of the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum, and to do any and all 45 46 things which may be necessary or desirable to carry out such purpose; and 47

48 (e) To review and approve any major changes in the architecture, furnishings, objects of art and other matters 49 50 effecting the repair, preservation, operation, maintenance or protection of property of the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum. 51 SECTION 3. A special fund to be designated as the 52 (1) (a) 53 "Mississippi Civil Rights Museum Fund," is created in the State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as 54 a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General 55 Fund of the State. The special fund shall consist of funds 56 57 appropriated or otherwise made available by the Legislature in any

manner and funds from any other source designated for deposit into 58 such fund. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of 59 60 a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any

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investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fundshall be deposited to the credit of the fund.

(b) Monies in the fund shall be disbursed, in the
discretion of the Department of Finance and Administration, to pay
the costs of designing, constructing and maintaining the
Mississippi Civil Rights Museum.

67 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration shall
68 proceed with the planning, construction, furnishing and equipping
69 of a facility to house the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum as soon
70 as practicable.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force fromand after July 1, 2001.
