HOUSE BILL NO. 441

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 57-61-32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 WHICH PROVIDES FUNDS TO DEFRAY COSTS OF THE STATE'S SHARE IN THE 2 NORTH MISSISSIPPI FISH HATCHERY AND THE LOWER EAST PEARL RIVER 3 WATER DIVERSION PROJECT, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF REPEAL FROM 4 DECEMBER 31, 2001, TO DECEMBER 31, 2002; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 57-61-32, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 57-61-32. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter 9 to the contrary, the Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks 10 11 shall certify to the department the amount of money necessary to 12 defray the cost of the state's share in constructing the North 13 Mississippi fish hatchery, which amount shall not be more than 14 Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00); and the department shall, if funds have not otherwise been made available, provide a grant for 15 such amount out of the proceeds of bonds issued under this 16 17 chapter. Of the funds provided hereunder, any amounts not 18 expended on the fish hatchery shall be remitted to the department for deposit into the Mississippi Business Investment Sinking Fund. 19 20 The private match requirements of Section 57-61-9(2)(d), 21 Mississippi Code of 1972, shall not apply to any loan or grant made under this section. 22 23 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, the Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks shall 24 25 certify to the department the amount of money necessary to defray the costs of the state's share in constructing the water diversion 26 27 project on the lower East Pearl River, beginning at the Wilson Slough Breakout down through the Farrs Slough and Holmes Bayou to 28 *HR03/R652* H. 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the Hobolochitto Creek, which amount shall not be more than Four 29 Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00); and if the United States Army 30 31 Corps of Engineers receives approval for the construction of such 32 project, and if the United States has committed funding for the 33 project, then the department shall provide a grant for such amount out of the proceeds of bonds issued under this chapter. Of the 34 funds provided in this subsection, any amounts not expended on the 35 project described herein shall be remitted to the department for 36 deposit into the Mississippi Business Investment Sinking Fund. 37 The provisions of this subsection (2) shall stand repealed from 38 39 and after December 31, 2002.

40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2001.
