## HOUSE BILL NO. 455

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF 1 TRANSPORTATION SHALL PERFORM CERTAIN PROJECTS ON AND ALONG THAT 2 3 PART OF U.S. HIGHWAY 49 FROM U.S. HIGHWAY 90 TO U.S. HIGHWAY 80 AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO UPGRADE SUCH HIGHWAY TO THE SAME OR SIMILAR 4 STANDARDS FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION THAT ARE REQUIRED FOR THOSE 5 HIGHWAYS INCLUDED WITHIN THE 1987 FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY PROGRAM; TO 6 7 CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE KNOWN AS THE "49 HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS FUND", AND TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES IN THE 8 SPECIAL FUND MAY BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING EXPENSES 9 10 RELATED TO THE PROJECTS AUTHORIZED BY THIS ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT UNTIL JULY 1, 2008, A PORTION OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF TAXES, FEES AND PENALTIES 11 12 COLLECTED BY THE STATE TAX COMMISSION UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING 13 CONTROL ACT SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE HIGHWAY 49 IMPROVEMENTS 14 FUND, AND THAT THEREAFTER SUCH PORTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE 15 STATE HIGHWAY FUND FOR USE IN THE MAINTENANCE AND UPKEEP OF STATE 16 HIGHWAYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 17

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 19 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Department of 20 Transportation, subject to the availability of funds, shall perform such projects for the construction and reconstruction to 21 22 that part of U.S. Highway 49 that runs between U.S. Highway 90 and U.S. Highway 80 as may be necessary to upgrade such highway to the 23 same or similar standards for design and construction that are 24 25 required for those four-lane highways and four-lane highway segments provided for under Section 65-3-97. Such projects may 26 27 include, but are not limited to, geometric, vertical and 28 horizontal alignment changes in the roadway; improvements to existing intersections; widening of shoulders; replacement of 29 bridges; relocating existing lanes and adding lanes; providing 30 access control; constructing frontage roads; providing turn lanes; 31 and creating additional interchanges. The department may acquire 32 33 such right-of-way as may be necessary for performance of the 34 projects.

H. B. No. 455 01/HR03/R932 PAGE 1 (JWB\LH) 35 (2) Funds for the projects authorized under subsection (1) 36 of this section shall be provided from monies deposited into and 37 credited to the Highway 49 Improvements Fund created in Section 2 38 of House Bill \_\_\_\_, 2001 Regular Session.

(3) (a) The Department of Transportation shall submit a
report to the Legislature by January 10 of each year setting forth
the current status of the projects prescribed in subsection (1) of
this section, which report shall include:

43 (i) The specific projects upon which engineering44 is being performed or has been completed;

45 (ii) The specific projects for which right-of-way46 has been acquired or is being acquired;

47 (iii) The specific projects for which construction48 contracts have been let;

49 (iv) The specific projects upon which construction50 is in progress;

51 (v) The specific projects upon which construction52 has been completed;

53 (vi) Projections for completion of the next step 54 on each project;

For each fiscal year, beginning with fiscal 55 (vii) 56 year 2002, a detailed cash flow projection by source of program activities and an estimate of when or if a funding shortage will 57 be encountered due to costs exceeding original projections; 58 A schedule of all complete and 59 (viii) open-to-traffic highway projects and the related total cost of 60 61 each project;

(ix) A complete recap of all program receipts by
source, and of all disbursements for the prior fiscal year and
cumulative totals since the inception of the program as compared
to projections; and

66 (x) A statement from the Department of
67 Transportation regarding the status of the funding of the program
68 based on agency cost experience and projections for the future.

(b) The report shall be deemed submitted when ten (10)
copies are received by the Clerk of the House of Representatives
and ten (10) copies are received by the Secretary of the Senate.

(4) The Transportation Commission shall give notice in some 72 73 newspaper or newspapers having a general circulation throughout 74 the counties in which any project is proposed under this section for the purpose of conducting hearings from time to time and 75 76 receiving comments and suggestions from members of the public 77 regarding such improvements or modifications to roadway design, engineering or traffic control that may be needed to increase 78 safety and reduce highway accidents and fatalities. 79

SECTION 2. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a 80 special fund to be designated as the "Highway 49 Improvements 81 Fund." The fund shall consist of such monies as are required to 82 83 be deposited into the fund under the provisions of Section 75-76-129, and such other monies from any other source as the 84 85 Legislature may direct. Monies in the fund may be expended, upon legislative appropriation, for the sole purpose of defraying the 86 87 expenses of the Mississippi Transportation Commission and the Mississippi Department of Transportation for the planning, design, 88 engineering, construction, reconstruction and other expenses 89 90 incurred by the Transportation Commission and the Department of Transportation for the projects designated in Section 1 of House 91 92 Bill \_\_\_\_, 2001 Regular Session.

93 (2) Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the 94 end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, 95 and any interest earned on amounts in the special fund shall be 96 deposited to the credit of the special fund.

97 SECTION 3. Section 75-76-129, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 98 amended as follows:

An amount equal to Three Million Dollars 115 116 (\$3,000,000.00) of the revenue collected during that month pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) shall be 117 118 deposited by the State Tax Commission into the bond sinking fund created in Section 65-39-3. The revenue collected during that 119 120 month pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) that is in excess of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00), but is 121 less than twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount of revenue 122 123 collected under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) during that month, shall be deposited into the State Highway Fund to be used exclusively 124 125 for the reconstruction and maintenance of highways of the State of Mississippi. An amount equal to Two Million Eighty-three Thousand 126 Three Hundred Thirty-three Dollars and Thirty-three Cents 127 (\$2,083,333.33), shall be deposited by the State Tax Commission 128 129 into the Highway 49 Improvements Fund created under Section 2 of 130 House Bill \_\_\_\_\_, 2001 Regular Session.

The local government fees shall be 146 distributed by the State Tax Commission pursuant to Section 147 148 75-76-197. An amount equal to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of the revenue collected during that month 149 pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) shall be 150 deposited by the State Tax Commission into the bond sinking fund 151 created in Section 65-39-3. The revenue collected during that 152 month pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) 153 that is in excess of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00), but is 154 155 less than twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount of revenue collected under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) during that month, shall 156 157 be deposited into the State Highway Fund to be used exclusively for the reconstruction and maintenance of highways of the State of 158 The Two Million Eighty-three Thousand Three Hundred 159 Mississippi. 160 Thirty-three Dollars and Thirty-three Cents (\$2,083,333.33) shall be deposited by the State Tax Commission into the State Highway 161 Fund and may be expended, upon legislative appropriation, only for 162 maintenance and upkeep of highways on the state highway system. 163 H. 75-76-129. On or before the last day of each month, all 166 167 taxes, fees, interest, penalties, damages, fines or other monies 168 collected by the State Tax Commission during that month under the provisions of this chapter, with the exception of (a) the local 169 government fees imposed under Section 75-76-195, and (b) Two 170 Million Eighty-three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-three Dollars 171 and Thirty-three Cents (\$2,083,333.33) shall be paid by the State 172 Tax Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited in the State 173 174 General Fund. The local government fees shall be distributed by the State Tax Commission pursuant to Section 75-76-197. 175 The Two Million Eighty-three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-three Dollars 176 and Thirty-three Cents (\$2,083,333.33) shall be deposited by the 177 State Tax Commission into the State Highway Fund and may be 178 expended, upon legislative appropriation, only for maintenance and 179 upkeep of highways on the state highway system. 180 181 SECTION 4.
